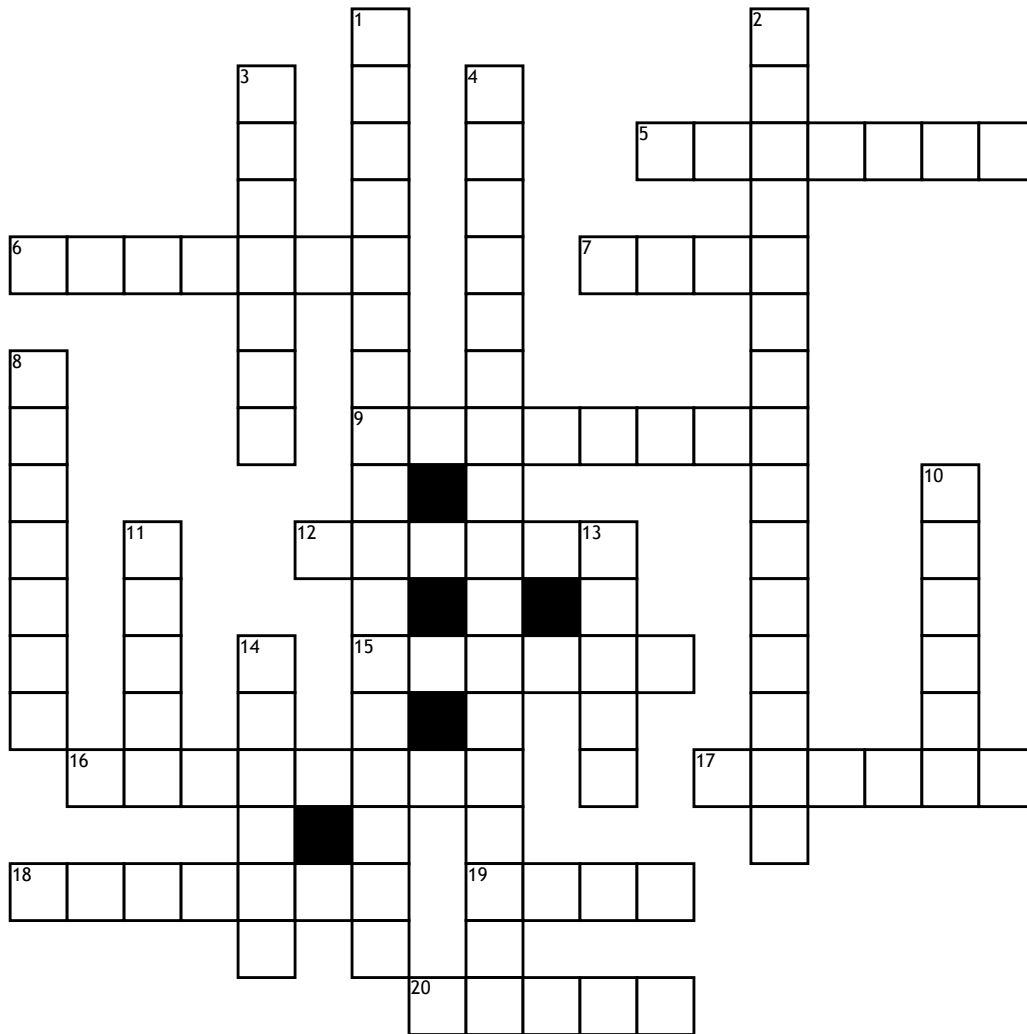

5. the bone of the upper arm or forelimb, forming joints at the shoulder and the elbow.
 6. the kneecap
 7. the thinner and longer of the two bones in the human forearm, on the side opposite to the thumb
 9. technical term for collarbone
 12. the large bony structure near the base of the spine to which the hind limbs or legs are attached
 15. a group of small bones between the main part of the hind limb and the metatarsus in terrestrial vertebrates

16. the jaw or a jawbone

17. relating to the bones forming the human carpus (wrist)

18. technical term for shoulder blade.

19. each of a series of slender curved bones articulated in pairs to the spine
 20. the bone of the thigh or upper hind limb, articulating at the hip and the knee.

1. twelve small bones that form the vertebral spine in the upper trunk
 2. the area of the spinal column that comprises the low back
 3. a bone of the finger or toe

4. the vertebrae of the neck

8. the breastbone

10. the outer and usually smaller of the two bones between the knee and the ankle

11. the inner and typically larger of the two bones between the knee and the ankle

13. a framework of bone or cartilage enclosing the brain of a vertebrate; the skeleton of a person's or animal's head.

14. the thicker and shorter of the two bones in the human forearm
