

## Skeletal System



## Across

- 3. thin layer, membrane, scale, or platelike tissue or part, especially in bone tissue
- **4.** Plate of hyaline cartilage at the junction of the diaphysis and epiphysis that provides with growth in length of a long bone
- 7. Houses blood vessels and nerves within the bone
- 11. Dense layer of vascular connective tissue enveloping the bones except at the surfaces of the joints
- ${f 13.}$  shaft or central part of a long bone
- 16. Mature bone cell
- 17. Hyaline cartilage covering bone ends of movable joints

- 19. Also called cortical or dense bone, body matrix is solidly filled with organic ground substances and inorganic salt. The rest of the tiny spaces contain osteocytes
- 20. Unfilled space or gap within a bone

## Down

- 1. Spongy bone covered in articular cartilage, ending bones bones to move at the joints without grinding on eachother
- 2. Central cavity of a long bone and contains yellow or red bone marrow
- **5.** Bone marrow of children and some adult bones that is required for the formation of red blood cells

- 6. bone marrow with fat, found at the ends of long bones in adults
- 8. large cells that resorb or break down bone matrix
- 9. Enlarged terminal part of the bone, nearest to the center of the body and made of spongy tissue
- 10. Area of growth in a long bone, layer of hyaline cartilage where ossification occurs
- 12. Bone forming cells
- 14. Helps transport nutrients to bone tissue and supply blood from periosteum
- 15. lattice-like matrix called trabeculae (what gives it its spongy appearance)
- 18. System of interconnecting canals in the microscopic structure of adult compact bone
