Skin Alterations

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| 1. Small solid rounded bumps usually less than 1 centimeter in diameter | A. Macule |
| 2. A small circumscribed elevation of the skin containing pus and having an inflamed base | B. Plaque |
| 3. Flat area of color change in the skin that is 1 cm or more wide | C. Papule |
| 4. Raised, itchy areas of skin | D. Patches |
| 5. A patch of skin that is altered in color but usually not elevated | E. Urticaria |
| 6. A broad, raised area on the skin greater than 1 cm in diameter | F. Wheal |
| 7. Solid, elevated areas of tissue or fluid inside or under the skin with a diameter greater than 0.5 centimeters | G. Pustule |
| 8. fluid collection in the layer of skin below the surface (welt) | H. Vesicle |
| 9. A small fluid-filled blister on the skin less than 5 mm in diameter | I. Nodule |
| 10. A fluid-filled blister more than 5 mm in diameter | J. Bullae |
