

- **2.** Viral infection commonly known as shingles, affects the spinal nerve
- **8.** Pigmentation disorder mainly apparent in pregnancy where a butterfly mask appearance is visible on the face
- **9.** Fungal infection known as athletes foot, highly infectious
- **10.** Pigmentation disorder known as 'liver spots'
- **11.** An infestation that is caused by mites burrowing in the skin leaving small red blotches

- **12.** Bacterial infection causing blisters which weep and leave a thick yellow crust
- **13.** Viral infection, small blisters form around the mouth and can dry up and crust, highly contagious
- **14.** Bacterial infection, Skin has blocked glands caused by excess sebum and is shiny with pustules and papules with pitted scarring
- 1. Viral infection, small warts found on the feet
- **3.** Fungal infection which attaches to the keratinised structures of the skin, known as ring worm

- **4.** Commonly known as 'freckles' mainly evident on fair skinned individuals
- **5.** Bacterial infection of the pilo sebaceous duct causing inflammation
- **6.** Bacterial Infection mainly affecting menopausal women. Flushed/reddened appearance on the face
- **7.** A Congenital disorder where skin appears red and irritated, can be caused by clothing, cosmetics and products
