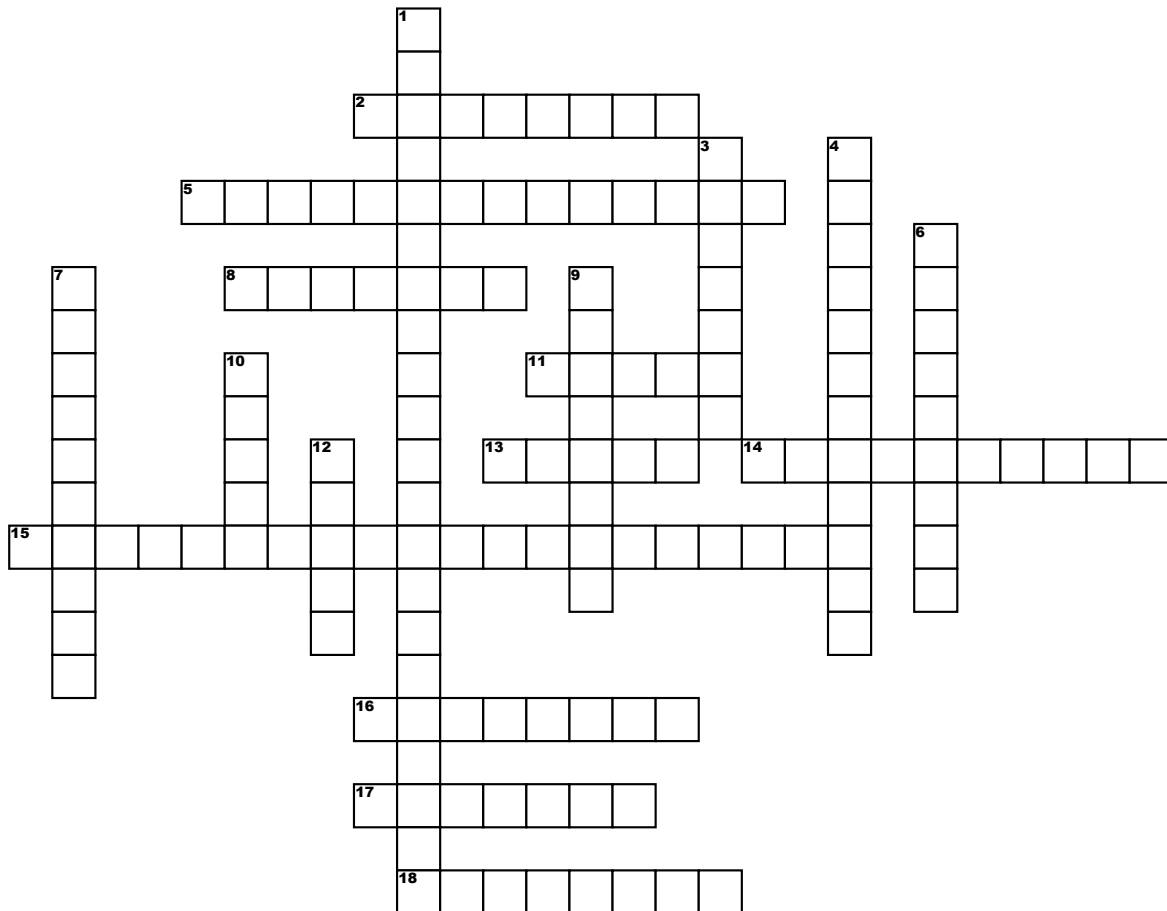

- 2. abnormal, rounded solid lump above/within or under the skin, larger than a papule**
- 5. a product designed to not clog follicles/pores**
- 8. Also known as a wart, hypertrophy of the skin**
- 11. Open lesion on skin, accompanied by pus/weeping fluids**
- 13. Any thin/dry/oily plate of epidermal flakes**
- 14. inflammatory condition of the skin**

15. skin condition caused by inflammation of sebaceous glands ae: redness/dry-oily scaling

16. Hereditary conditions causing splotches/spots on skin

17. Chronic condition on cheeks and nose, appears like flushing/redness

18. Absence of pigment in hair/skin/eyes caused by hypopigmentation of the body

1. type of skin cancer (scaly red papules or nodules) more serious than basal cell

3. a crack in the skin, penetrating the dermis

4. foul smelling perspiration of armpits or feet, caused by bacteria

6. skin condition of red patches covered with silver-white scales, usually located on scalp, elbows, knees, chest, lower back

7. skin disorder having light/abnormal patches (hypopigmentation), caused by burn or congenital disease

9. also known as liver spots

10. An abnormal mass varying in size, shape, color

12. Itchy, swollen lesion lasts only few hours, ae: hives/insect bites
