
Skin disease/disorders

- 2. abnormal, rounded solid lump above/within or under the skin, larger than a papule
- 5. a product designed to not clog follicles/pores
- **8.** Also known as a wart, hypertrophy of the skin
- 11. Open lesion on skin, accompanied by pus/weeping fluids
- 13. Any thin/dry/oily plate of epidermal flakes
- **14.** inflammatory condition of the skin

- 15. skin condition caused by inflammation of sebaceous glands ae: redness/dry-oily scaling
- 16. Hereditary conditions causing splotches/spots on skin
- 17. Chronic condition on cheeks and nose, appears like flushing/redness
- 18. Absence of piment in hair/skin/eyes caused by hypopigmentation of the body Down
- 1. type of skin cancer (scaly red papules or nodules) more serious than basal cell
- 3. a crack in the skin, penetrating the dermis

- 4. foul smelling perspiration of armpits or feet, caused by bacteria
- 6. skin condition of red patches covered with silver-white scales, usually located on scalp, elbows, knees, chest, lower back
- 7. skin disorder having light/abnormal patches (hypopigmentation), caused by burn or congenital disease
- 9. also known as liver spots
- **10.** An abnormal mass varying in size, shape, color
- 12. Itchy, swolen lesion lasts only few hours, ae: hives/insect bites
