

- 1. Failure of the palatine bones to unite
- 3. Covers top of the skull
- **4.** Bones that form bridge of nose
- 6. Round making behind ear
- **7.** Forms most of the top of the nasal cavity and the medial wall of the eye socket
- **8.** holes through which nerves run to teeth
- **9.** Bat shaped bone that forms part of the bottom of the cranium and the back floor of the eye socket

- **10.** Occurs when plate is off center
- 11. Bones that form back part of the roof of the mouth
- **13.** located in front of ethmoid on medial wall of eye socket
- 14. Avil shaped
- 19. Covers back of skull
- 23. located at bottom center of nasal cavity
