


Slaves, the Labor Force, and the Economy

- 9.** All free Roman citizens who were not members of the Patrician, Senate, or Equestrian classes.
- 10.** One of the wealthier social classes.

- 1.** Only the members of the senate could wear this.
- 2.** The ability of slaves to be freed.
- 3.** Foreigners, prisoners of war, or sailors captured by pirates.
- 4.** Was paid in the form of wheat of grain.
- 5.** Said to "treat your inferiors as you would like to be treated".
- 6.** Knights, originally in the cavalry, and later became a political class.
