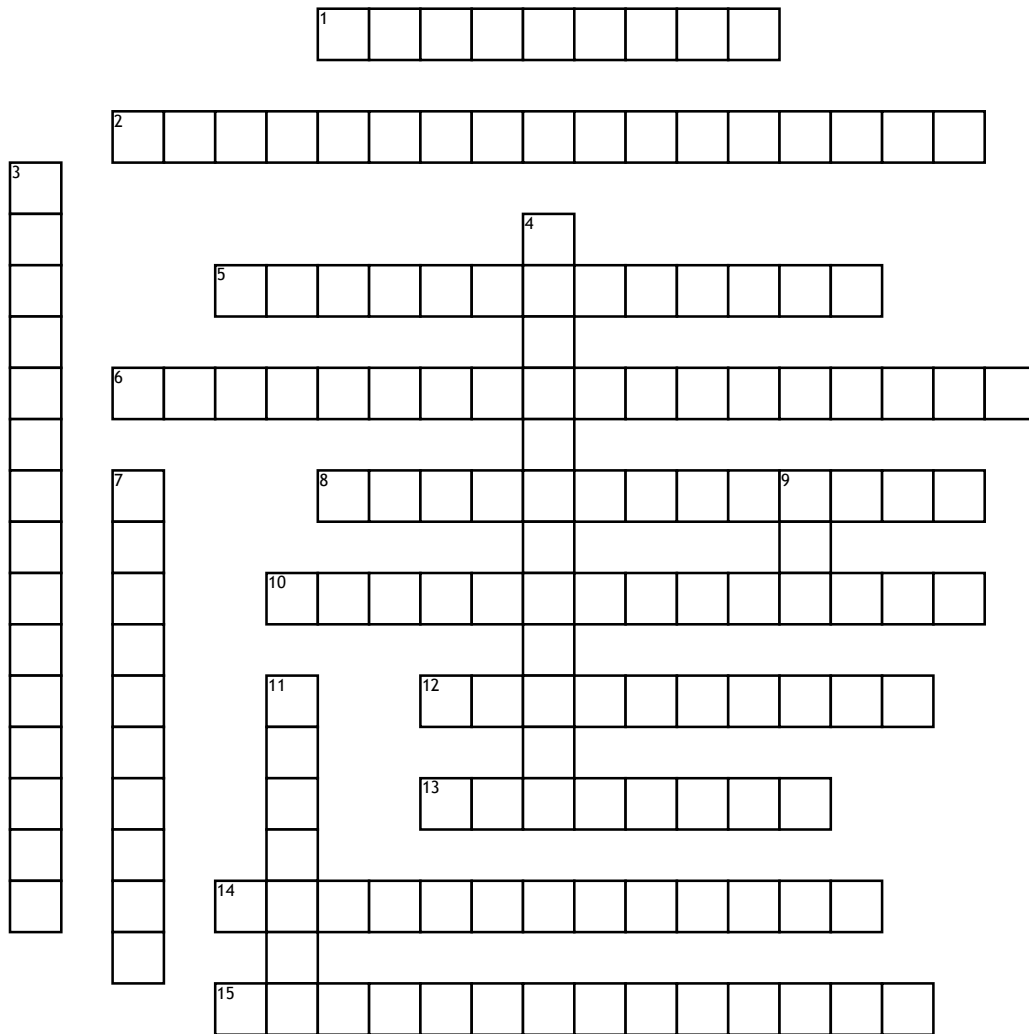


# Social Studies Project (crossword puzzle)
