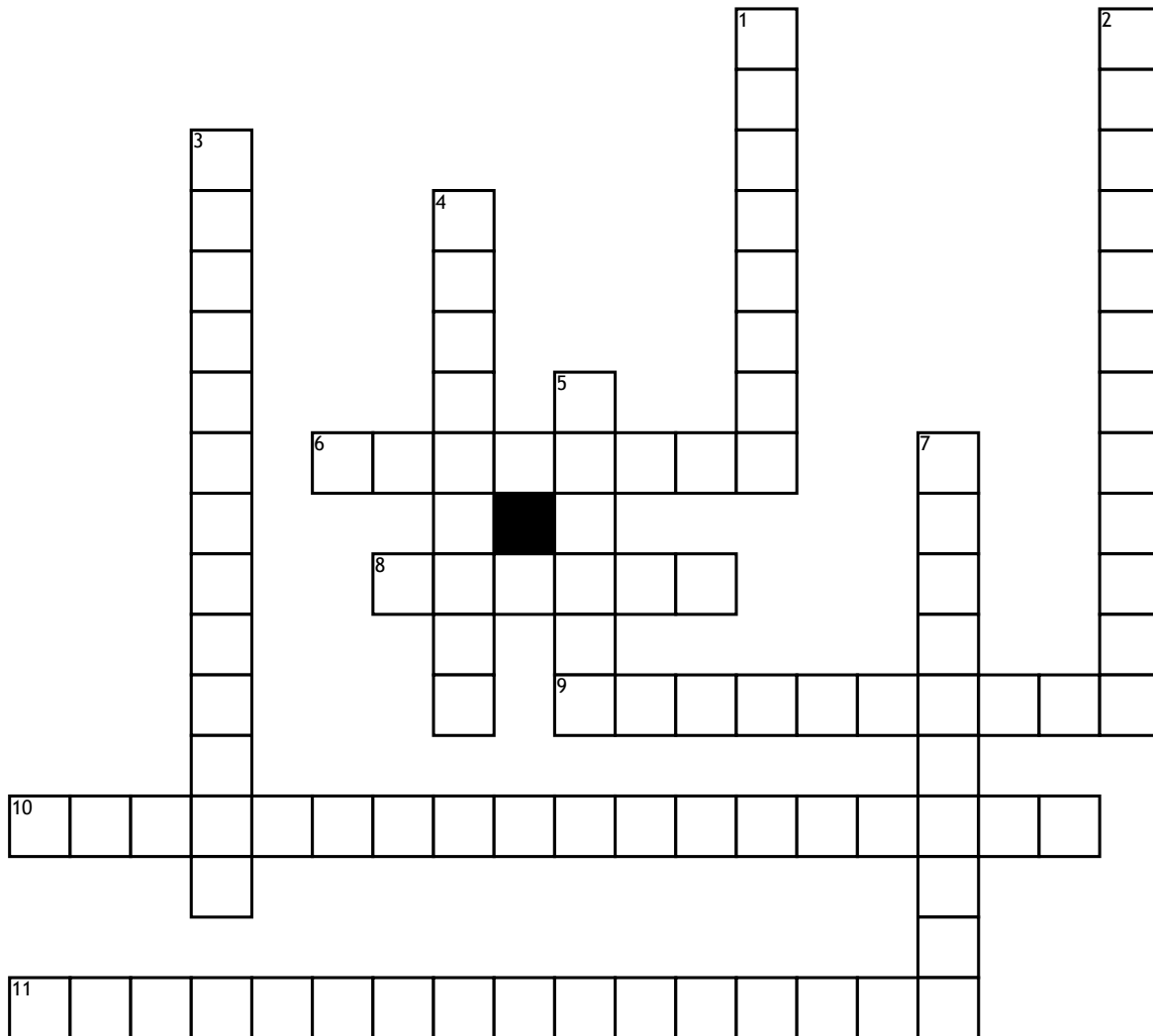

9. A desert, also known as the Great Indian Desert, is a large, arid region in the northwestern part of the Indian subcontinent that forms a natural boundary between India and Pakistan.
10. A mountain range of south-central Asia extending about 2,400 km (1,500 mi) through Kashmir, northern India, southern Tibet, Nepal, and Bhutan.
11. A river about 1800 miles (2900 kilometers) Asia flowing from the Himalayas in Tibet to the Ganges Delta in India.
