

7. A vast mountain system in southern Asia that extends for 1,500 miles (2,400 km) from Kashmir east to Assam

**8.** A vast land of flat hard ground and extreme hot weather conditions

**10.** A river in southern Asia, about 1,800 miles (2,900 km) long, that flows from Tibet through Kashmir and Pakistan to the Arabian Sea

**11.** A large, distinguishable part of a continent, such as India

**1.** A triangular plateau in southern India, bounded by the Malabar Coast in the west, the Coromandel Coast in the east, and the Vindhaya mountains in the north

**2.** A river in southern Asia that rises in the Himalayas and flows for 1,800 miles (2,900 km) through Tibet, northeastern India, and Bangladesh to join the Ganges River at its delta on the Bay of Bengal

4. An area of relatively level high ground

**5.** A seasonal prevailing wind in the region of South and Southeast Asia, blowing from the southwest between May and September and bringing rain (the wet monsoon), or from the northeast between October and April (the dry monsoon)

6. A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another such stream
9. A desert region to the east of the Indus River that lies in the states of Rajasthan and Gujarat in northwestern India and in the Punjab and Sind regions of southeastern Pakistan. Also called Great Indian Desert
