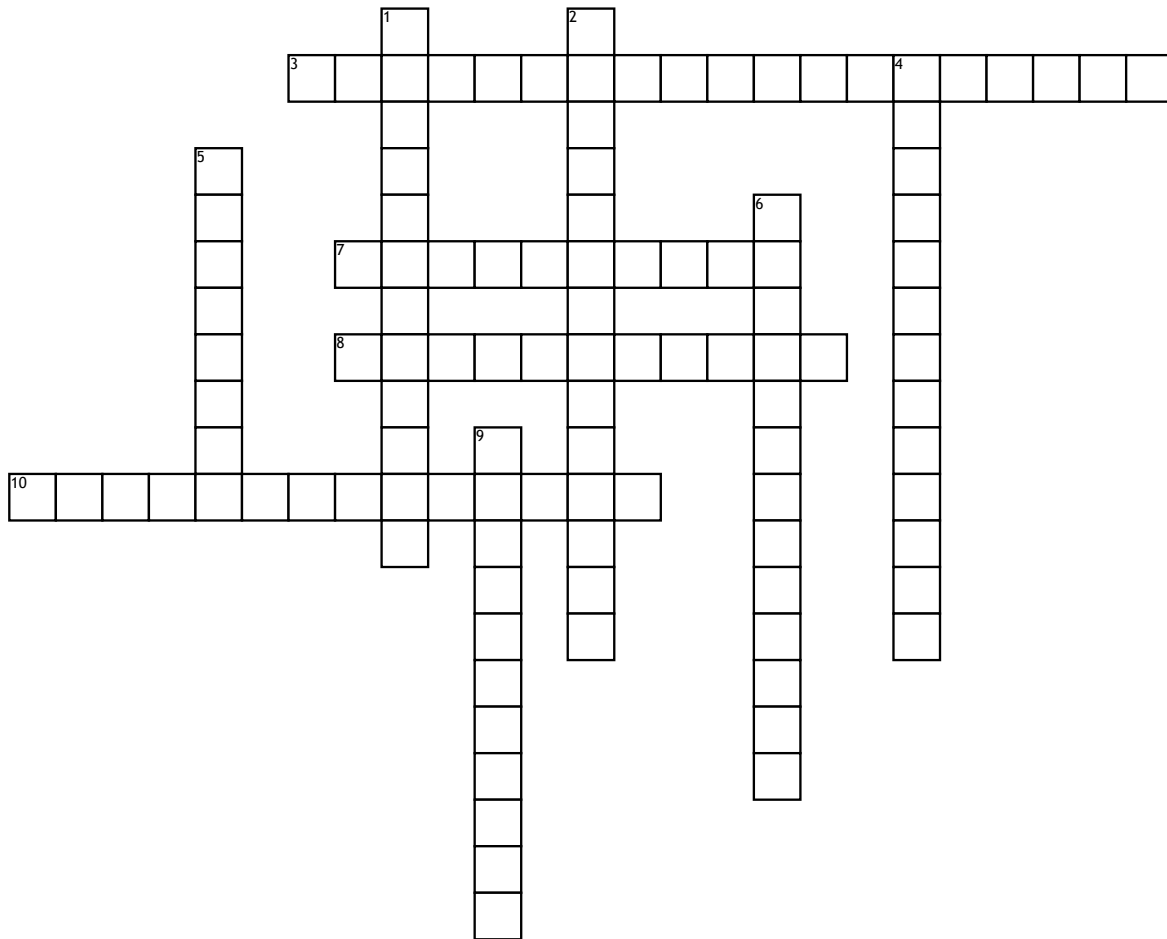

1. Spanish conquistador who defeated the Aztecs in 1521 and conquered Mexico

2. 16th century Spaniards who fanned out across the Americas, from Colorado to Argentina, eventually conquering the Aztec and Incan empires
 4. A spanish fleet that was conquered by smaller, swifter English ships and a storm in 1588; marked the beginning of the end of Spanish imperial dreams and ensured English naval dominance in the North Atlantic
 5. people of mixed Indian and European heritage, notably in Mexico
 6. fought between Spaniards under Don Juande Oñate and the Pueblo Indians in present-day New Mexico. Spaniards brutally crushed the Pueblo peoples and established the territory as New Mexico in 1609
 9. false notion that Spanish conquerors did little but butcher the Indians and steal their gold in the name of Christ
