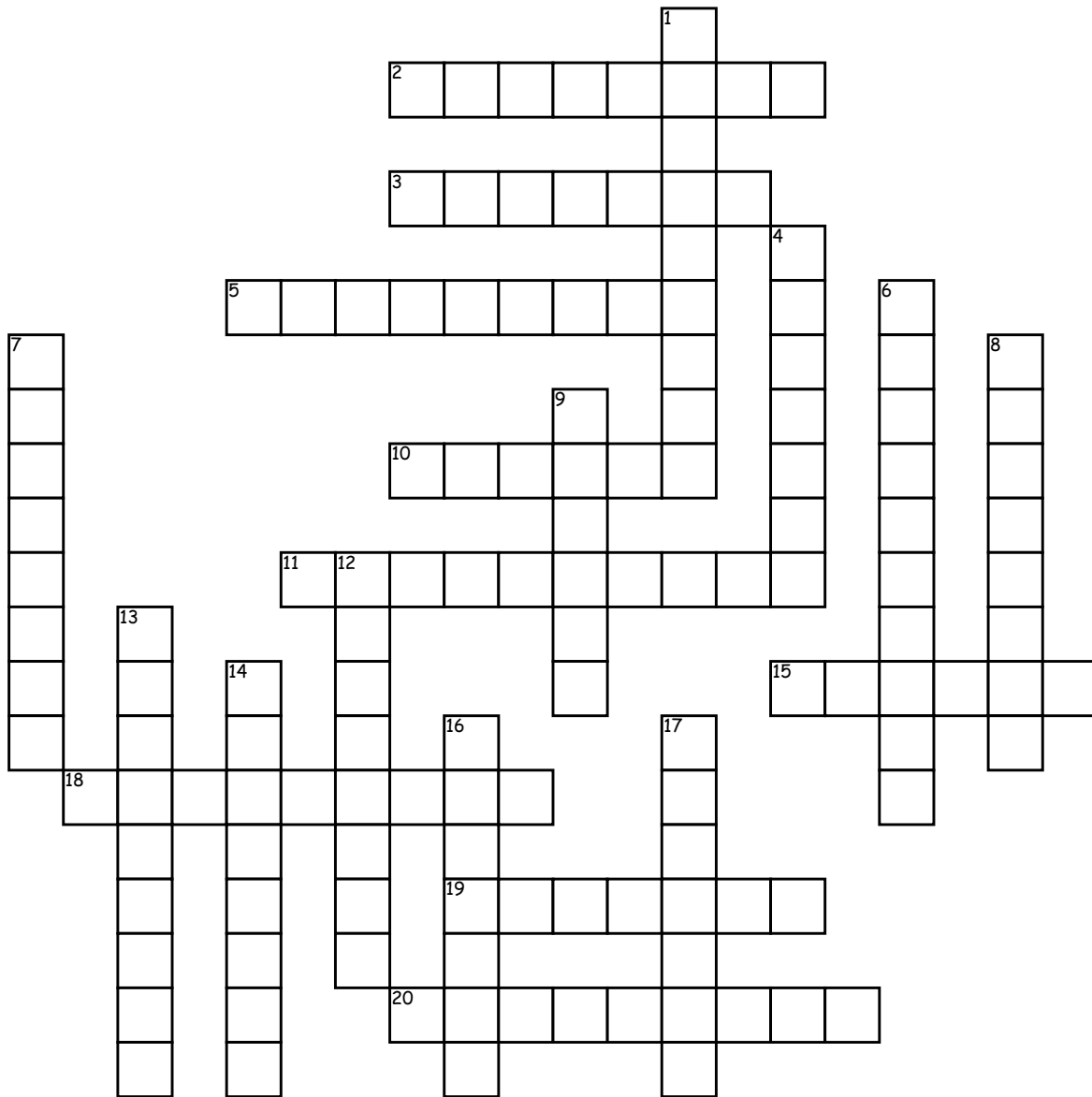


Spelling Crossword Puzzle
