

<u>Across</u>

- **4.** A person who disbelieves or lacks belief in the existence of God or gods
- **9.** Specialized medical care for people with serious illness, focusing on providing relief from the symptoms and stress of a serious illness
- **12.** A person who claims neither faith nor disbelief in God
- **14.** Can be recognized by others as well as the person sustaining the loss such as loss of limb, loss of spouse, or valued object
- **15.** A feeling of expectation and desire for a certain thing to happen
- **16.** A home providing care for the sick, especially the terminally ill

- **17.** The overcoming of limits of the individual self and its desires in spiritual contemplation and realization
- **18.** Grief reaction that occurs before an impending loss

- **1.** A disturbance in a person's belief system
- **2.** Loss occurring suddenly in response to a specific external effect
- **3.** Loss that is uniquely defined by the grieving person, typically overlooked or misunderstood
- **5.** Characterized by the treatment of the whole person, taking into account mental and social factors, rather than just the physical symptoms of a disease

- **6.** Existence or experience beyond the normal or physical level
- **7.** A sense of connection to something bigger than ourselves, and typically involves a search for meaning in life
- **8.** Complete trust or confidence in someone or something
- **10.** Loss that is the result of the natural growth and development processes in our lives
- 11. Care of the body after death
- **13.** Deep sorrow, especially that caused by someone's death
