
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## Sports Med Crossword Puzzle



## **Across**

- **5.** The kneecap
- **7.** The bicep femoris attaches on this bone
- **8.** Sprain of the big toe joint from injury during sports activities.
- **9.** A disease characterized by the epiphyseal inflammation of the tibial tubercle
- **10.** Torn posterior cruciate ligament within the knee.
- **11.** Largest and most complex joint in the body

- **12.** A tiny crack in a bone caused by repetitive stress or force, often from overuse.
- **15.** A torn anterior cruciate ligament in the knee.

## **Down**

- 1. Sprain or tear in the medial collateral ligament.
- **2.** Injury of the achilles tendon, which connects the calf muscle to the heel bone.
- **3.** Inflammation of a thick band of tissue that connects the heel bone to the toes.

- **4.** Common injury, most often caused by the ankle rolling inward or outward
- **6.** 4 muscles of the anterior thigh: rectus femoris, vastus medialis, vastus intermedius, vastus lateralis
- **13.** Bone of the thigh, articulating at the hip and the knee.
- **14.** Inner and typically larger of the two bones between the knee and the ankle (or the equivalent joints in other terrestrial vertebrates), parallel with the fibula.
