3. What is the front of the stage area called? C. Upstage
4. What do you call the part of the stage to the right of centre stage D. Centre Stage
5. The part of the stage to the left of centre stage E. UpStage Left
6. What do you call the area towards the back corner of the stage, left of centre? F. Upstage Centre
7. What do you call the area towards the back corner of the stage that is right of centre? G. The Pit
8. What do you call the area towards the front corner of the stage left of centre? H. Stage Right
9. What do you call the area towards the front corner of the stage right of centre? I. Downstage Left
10. What do you call the area of the stage towards the back and centre of the stage? J. UpStage Right
11. What do you call the area of the stage towards the front and centre of the stage? K. Downstage Right
12. Traditionally this is at the front of the stage and where an orchestra would be placed. L. Apron
13. This term generally refers to the auditorium. M. The House
14. The area for the general public before they enter the theatre. N. Downstage
15. The frame structure at the front of traditional playing spaces. O. Proscenium Arch
16. A section of the stage floor which 'thrusts' towards the auditorium. P. Stage Left
