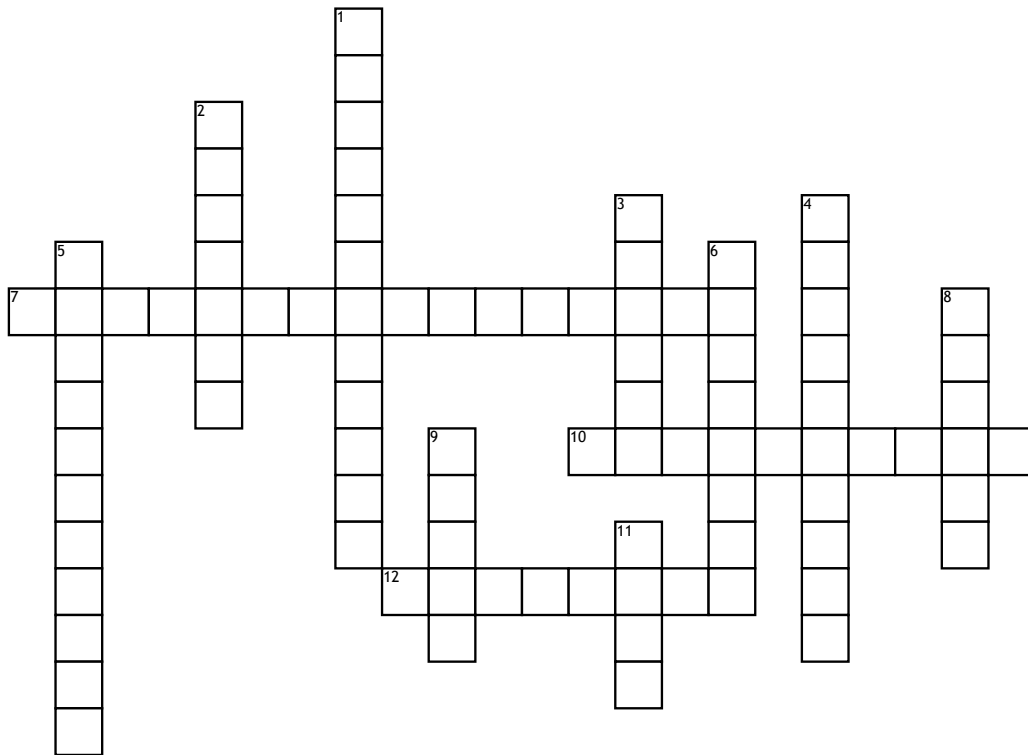

## Across

7. A crime committed within a business for financial gain
10. A crime or offense that is less serious than a felony; any minor misbehavior or misconduct. Punishments include fines and/or jail time ranging from 30 days to 12 months

1. The wrongful taking of another's property by a person who has been entrusted with that property
2. False making or materially altering a writing to defraud another
3. A place appointed by law for the detention of prisoners
4. A crime that involves a computer and a network
5. The criminal action of stealing goods from a store while pretending to be a customer

6. The aspect that is proportional to punishment (hint: it starts with an "s")
8. A crime, typically one involving violence, regarded as more serious than a misdemeanor, and usually punishable by imprisonment for more than one year or by death
