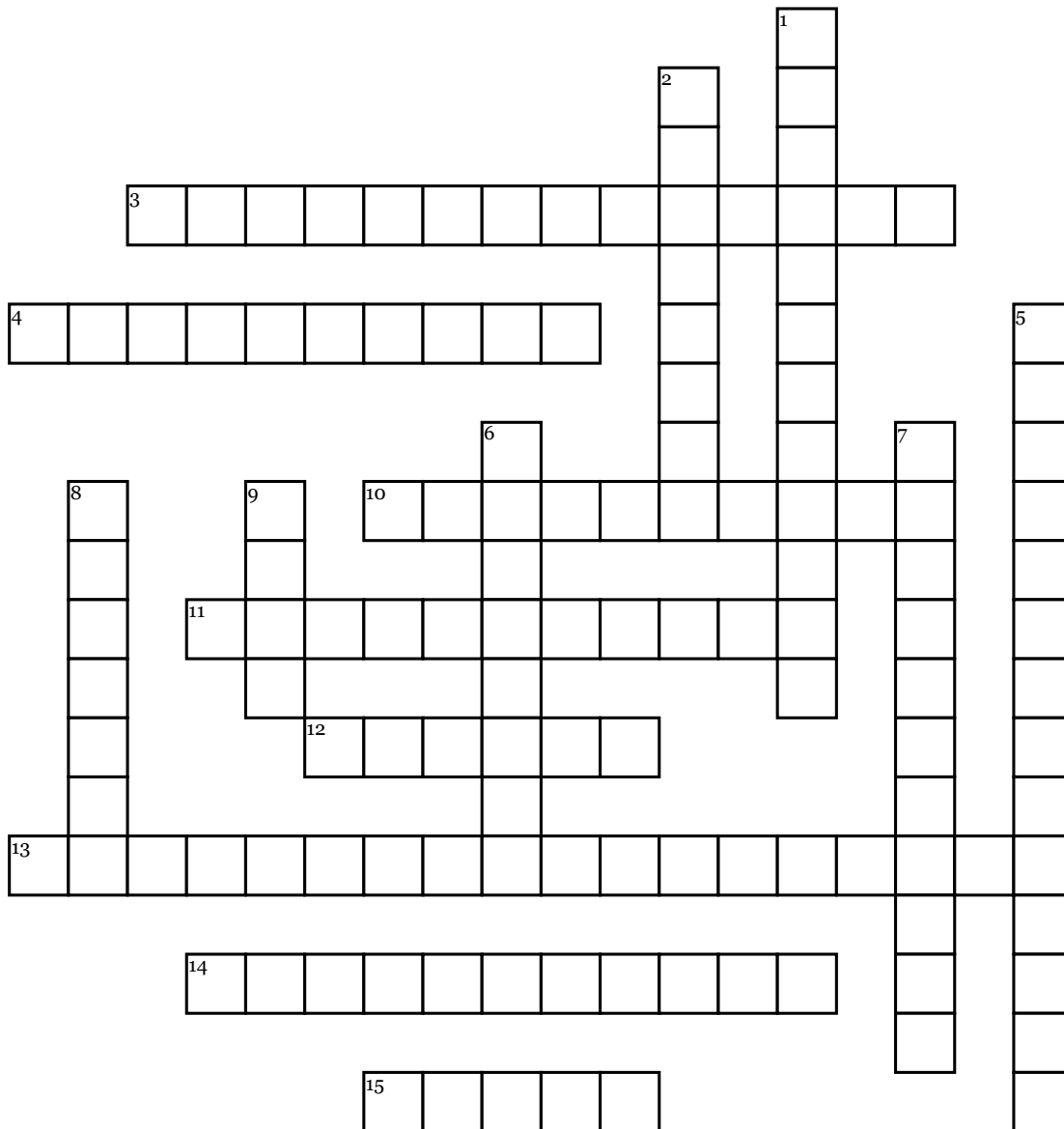


# Stop Crossword Puzzle
