

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Structure and function of the nail.



Across

- 4. Skin that overlaps the sides of the nail
- **7.** Folds of skin that overlap the sides of the nail plate for protection
- **9.** The semi white circle at the base of the nail
- **10.** Forms a seal between the free edge of the nail and the skin of the finger tip
- 11. This is the part that extends past the skin of the end of the tip

Down

- **1.** Protective shield of translucent keratin for the nail bed beneath.
- **2.** Cuticle that is situated at the base of the nail
- 3. Lies directly under the nail plate.
- **5.** The deep fold of skin at the base of the nail in which the nail root is embedded
- **6.** Tracks or slots in the skin on both sides of the nail upon which the nail moves out as it grows.
- **8.** Where the cells of the nail plate and nail bed are produced
