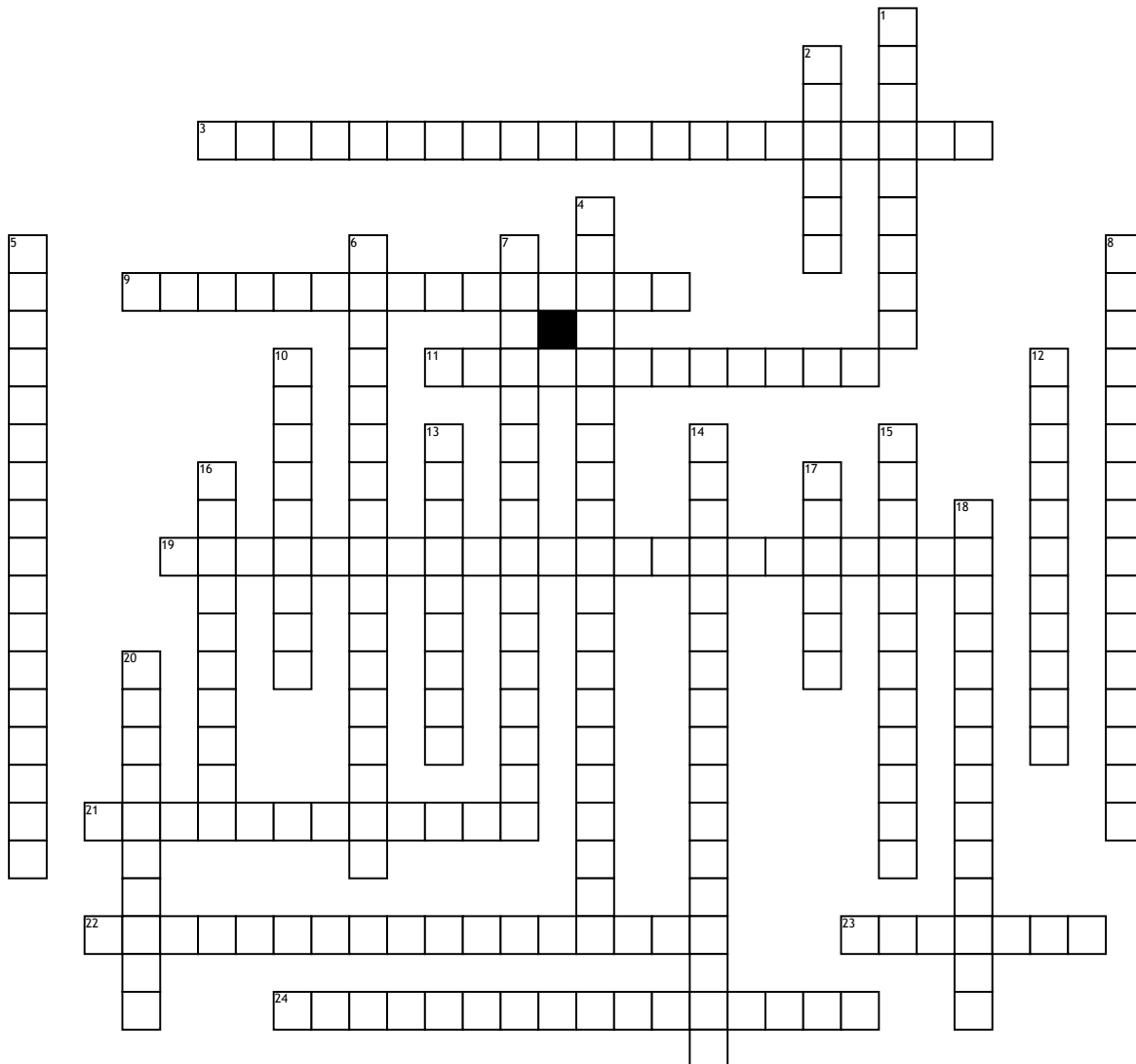

3. Authority of a court to review decisions of an inferior court
 9. Officially called "opinion of the court"; announces the court's decision of a case
 11. Case in which a defendant is tried for committing a crime as defined by law
 19. Power shared by both state and federal courts to hear a case
 21. Court composed of military personnel, charging someone with violating the military law
 22. Written explanation of the views of one or more judges who agree with the opinion of the court
 23. Satisfaction of a claim payment
 24. Order from a higher court directing a lower court to send up the record of a previous case for review

1. In civil Law, The party that brings legal action against another party
 2. Transcript of Proceedings made in trial court
 4. Power of a court to be the first to hear a case
 5. Idea that Judges should decide cases based strictly on the Framers intent
 6. Individual State's highest court
 7. Court operating as part of the judicial branch, independent of the military
 8. Idea that Judges should interpret the constitution and statutes of the case and decide based on their interpretations
