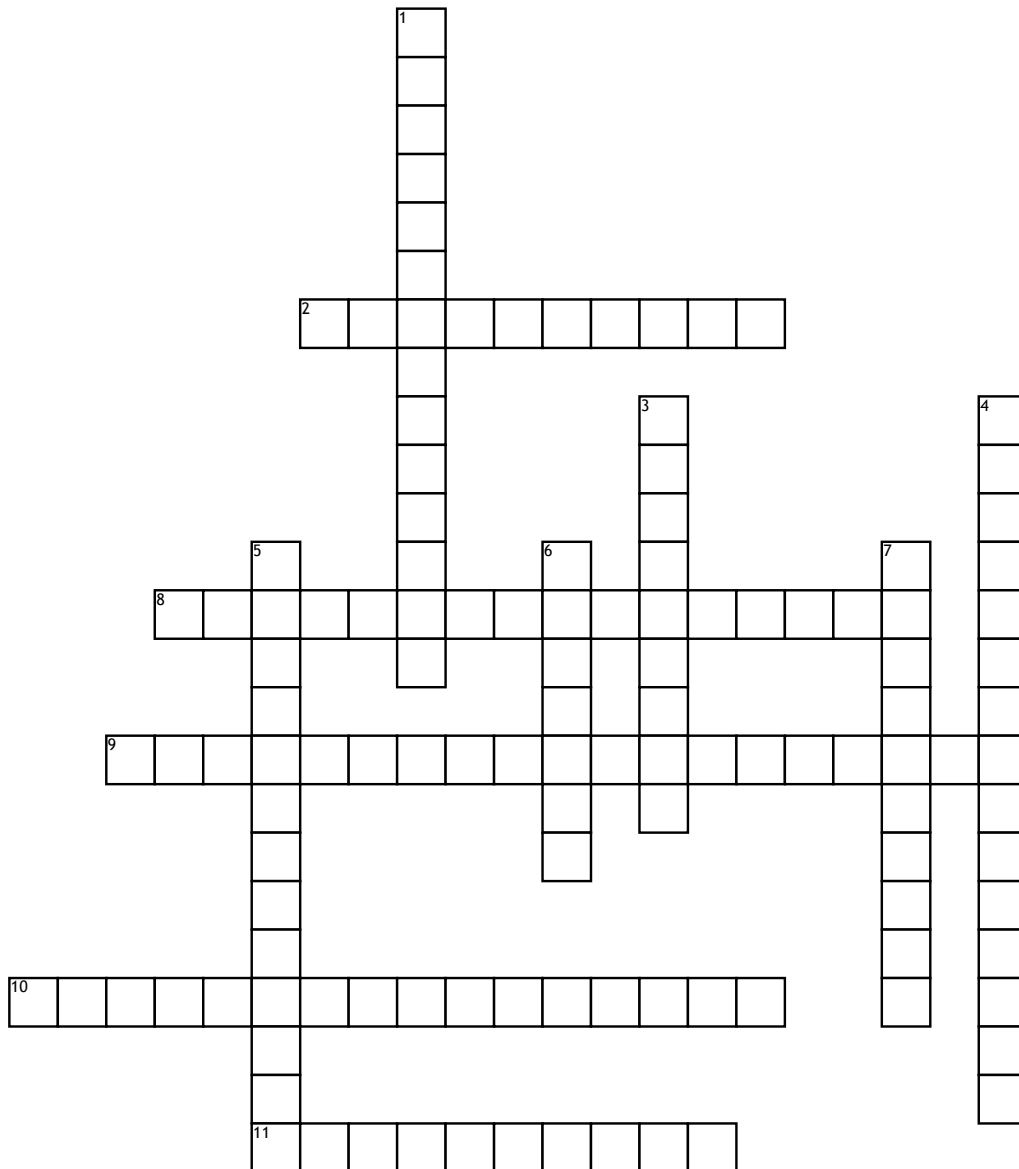

# Supreme Court Freedom of Speech Cases



## Across

2. a statement's falsity is not enough by itself to exclude speech from First Amendment protection
8. for public schools to censor speech they must show that the conduct would "materially and substantially interfere with the requirements of appropriate discipline in the operation of the school"
9. public school newspapers have a lower level of First Amendment protection

1. The government can suppress or punish speech that directly advocates the unlawful overthrow of the government.
