

Surgical Radiography

- 1. Provides intraoperative imaging in a variety of examinations and with various types of equipment
- Surgical procedure performed to alleviate pain caused by neural impingement by removing an aspect of the lamina in the vertebral arch
- 8. Designed to keep shoes clean and decrease the amount of soil and bacteria being tracked into the surgical area
- 9. Surgical procedure to restore the function of a joint
- 11. Surgical procedure where a fiber-optic instrument is inserted through the abdominal wall to permit a surgical procedure or view the organs of the abdomen
- 13. Images are recorded in rapid succession while contrast media is injected and then displayed as a moving image
- **15.** Licensed physician specially trained and qualified to perform surgical procedures
- 18. Rod or nail placed within the medullary cavity to reduce a fracture or stabilize a diseased long bone
- 20. Stiffening of a joint by operative means
- 24. Presence of pathogenic microorganisms in surgical area
- 26. Anterior Cruciate Ligament
- 28. Total Knee Replacement
- 29. Non-functional examination of the urinary grade during which contrast medium is introduced directly ret into the pelvicalyceal system via catheterization
- 30. Allows the physician or other operator to have hands-free operation of the C-arm

- 31. Endoscope used for examination of the urinary bladder
- 32. Surgical removal of gallbladder
- **34.** Surgical procedure designed to reduce proximal femoral fractures through the use of various internal fixation devices
- 35. Orthopedic screw designed to enter and fix porous spongy bone
- 36. A special OR table used for orthopedic procedures or hip pinning to provide traction to the involved limb and allow fluoroscopy to be performed during procedure Down
- 2. Active image displayed on monitor during procedure
- 3. The area of the OR that immediately surrounds and is specially prepared for the patient
- 5. Procedure performed during surgery to demonstrate
- The reason for several types of surgical radiography such as radiographs determining the exact location of foreign bodies
- 7. Fracture fragments are realigned by manipulation and are immobilized by cast or splint
- 10. Device for viewing inside the abdominal cavity
- 12. OR procedure that provides stability and pain relief to patients with vertebral compression fractures. Done by the injection of plastic cement (PMMA) into vertebral body.
- 14. Backwards, against the flow

- **16.** Used to hold images on monitor for reference purposes during procedure
- 17. The process of putting a limb, bone, or group of muscles under tension with the use of weights and pulleys to align or immobilize part
- 19. A state of sterility, living pathogens are absent
- 21. High Tibial Osteotomy
- 22. Mobile fluoroscopy unit that forms a large C shape with the x-ray tube located at one end and the image intensifier tower at the other
- 23. An isolation drape that separates the sterile field from the non-sterile environment
- 25. MRT present during these procedures, using the c-arm unit to provide fluoroscopic guidance for aligning bone fragments and placing hardware
- 27. Must be worn to tuck all hair away before entering into the surgical area
- 33. Total Hip Replacement
