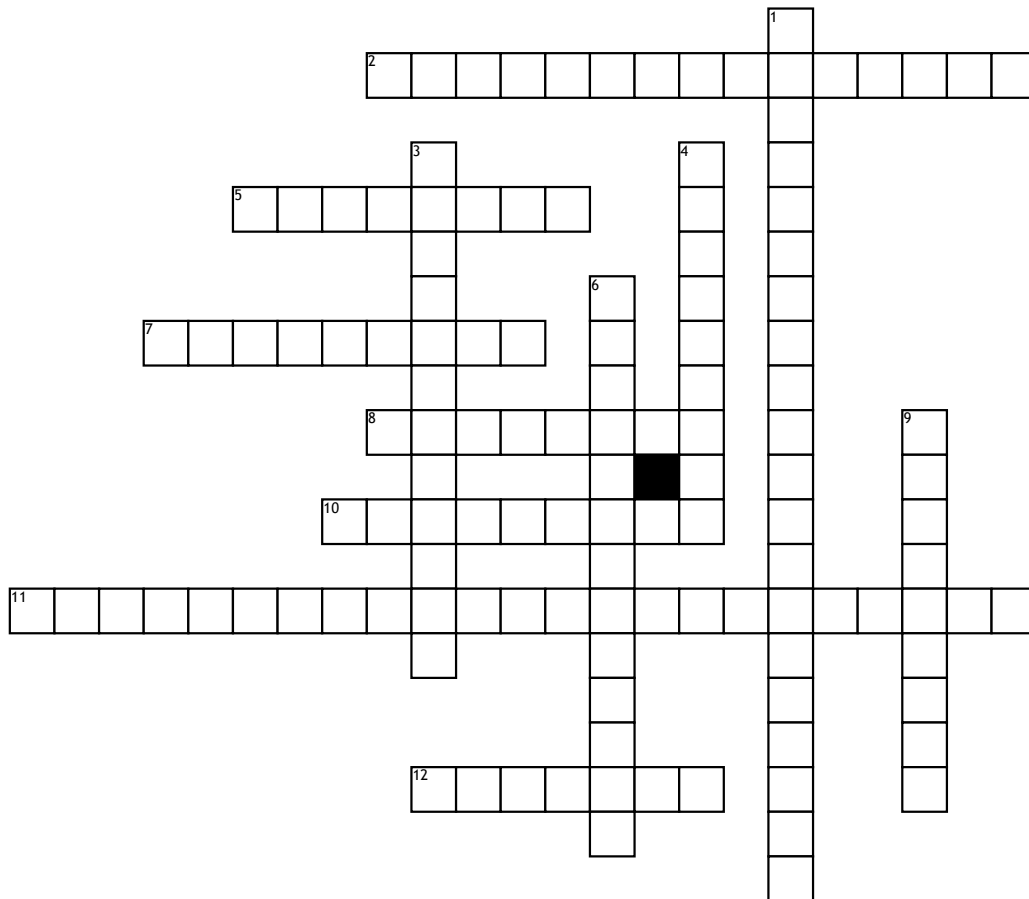

1. Monarchy in which power of the hereditary ruler is limited by the country's constitution and laws

6. A system of government that places most power in the legislature branch. The legislature, often called a parliament, chooses a prime minister, chancellor, or premier to act as the head of the government
