

- 3. working on a contractual basis rather than being employed by a specific company, giving tax and income responsibility to the worker
- 6. amount, based on a percentage of property value, paid to the local governments and school districts in which one lives
- 7. amount, based on the value of one's estate, which one's heirs or beneficiaries will pay to the government upon one's death
- ${f 9}.$ fixed amount of money to a person on a regular basis
- ${\bf 13.}$ amount of income after taxes and other deductions; also known as take-home pay
- 19. based hourly wage set by the federal government
- 21. Internal Revenue Service; federal bureau which collects taxes every year and turns money over to the Treasury Department to cover expenses of the U.S government
- 23. percentage paid of each sale, no base salary is available
- ${\bf 24.}\ \mbox{sum}$ of money given to an employee in addition to the employee's usual compensation
- 25. amount paid before commission

- 27. amount, based on percentage of one's taxable income, paid to the U.S and in some cases, to the state in which ones lives
- ${\bf 28.}$ salary range set by the government for all government jobs
- 29. payment for work done per hour

- $\overline{\textbf{1}}.$ amount, based on a percentage of a purchase, paid to the state and local governments in which one lives
- 2. national legislative body of U.S consisting of the Senate and House of Representatives as a continuous institution
- 4. social insurance program which provides unemployment compensation for a limited period to involuntary unemployed workers
- 5. amount deducted from a paycheck by an employer on the employee's behalf to pay federal income taxes based on the number of personal allowances claimed
- $\boldsymbol{8}.$ amount of money one is paid at the beginning of a job
- 10. tax, similar to a sales tax, imposed on some goods
- 11. amount of one's salary remaining after federal, state and often city income taxes and various other deductions have been withheld

- ${\bf 12.}$ payment for additional work done outside of regular working hours
- 14. amount of income before taxes and other deductions
- 15. person who relies on another for financial support
- 16. monetary credit received on one's tax return for each person claimed as a dependent
- 17. tax imposed on the transfer of money or property from one living person to another by gift, payable by the donor
- 18. Federal Insurance Contributions Act; a Social Security retirement tax
- 20. program under the U.S Social Security
 Administration which reimburses hospitals and physicians
 for medical care provided to qualifying people over 65
 years old; paid for by a set percentage taken out of one's
 paycheck and paid to the federal government during
 working years
- 22. government program which provides economic assistance to a person faced with unemployment, disability or old age; paid for by a set percentage taken out of one's paycheck and paid to the federal government during working years
- 26. fixed amount of money paid to a person on a regular basis for services rendered
