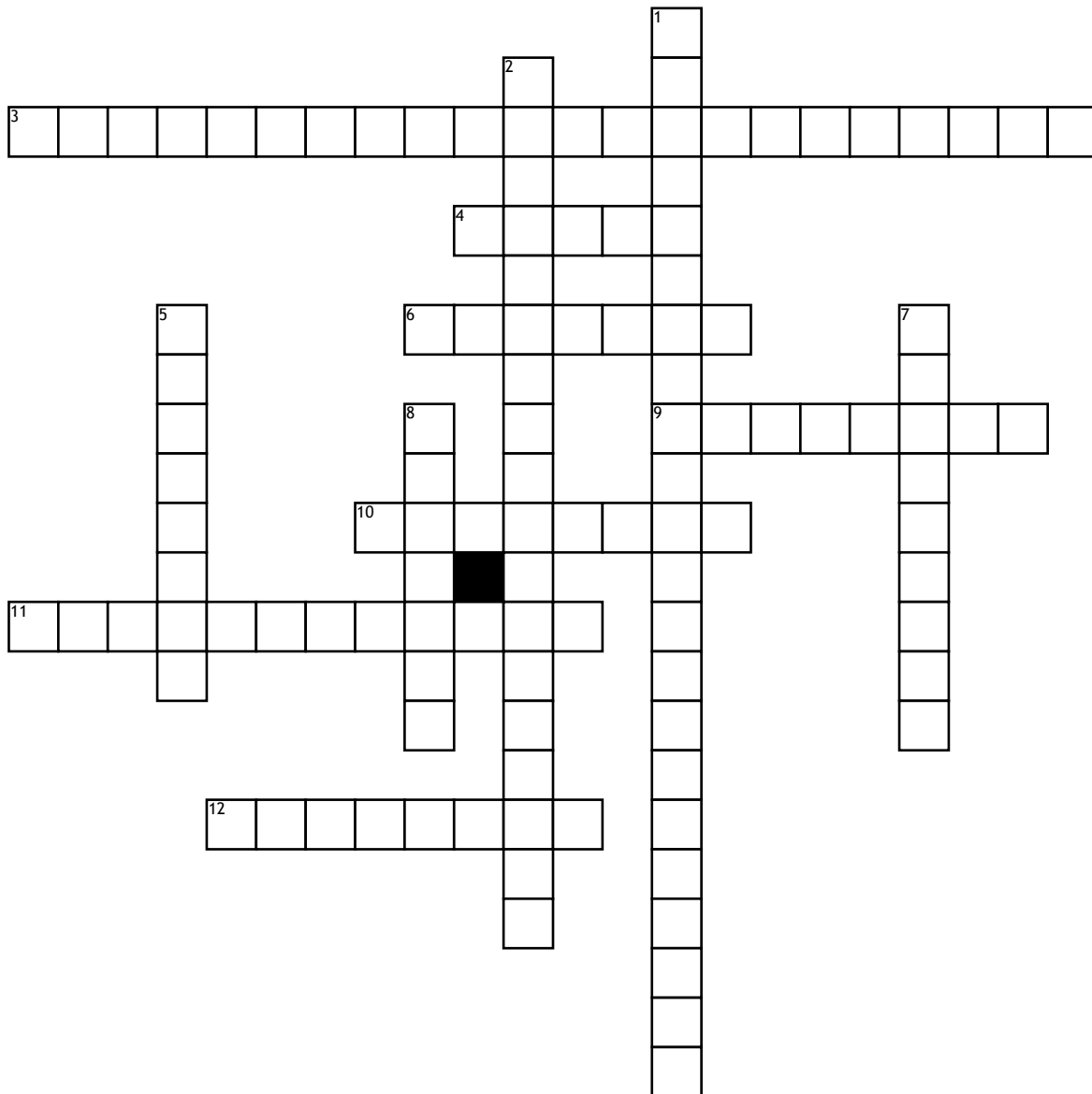


# Tell Tale Heart Crossword
