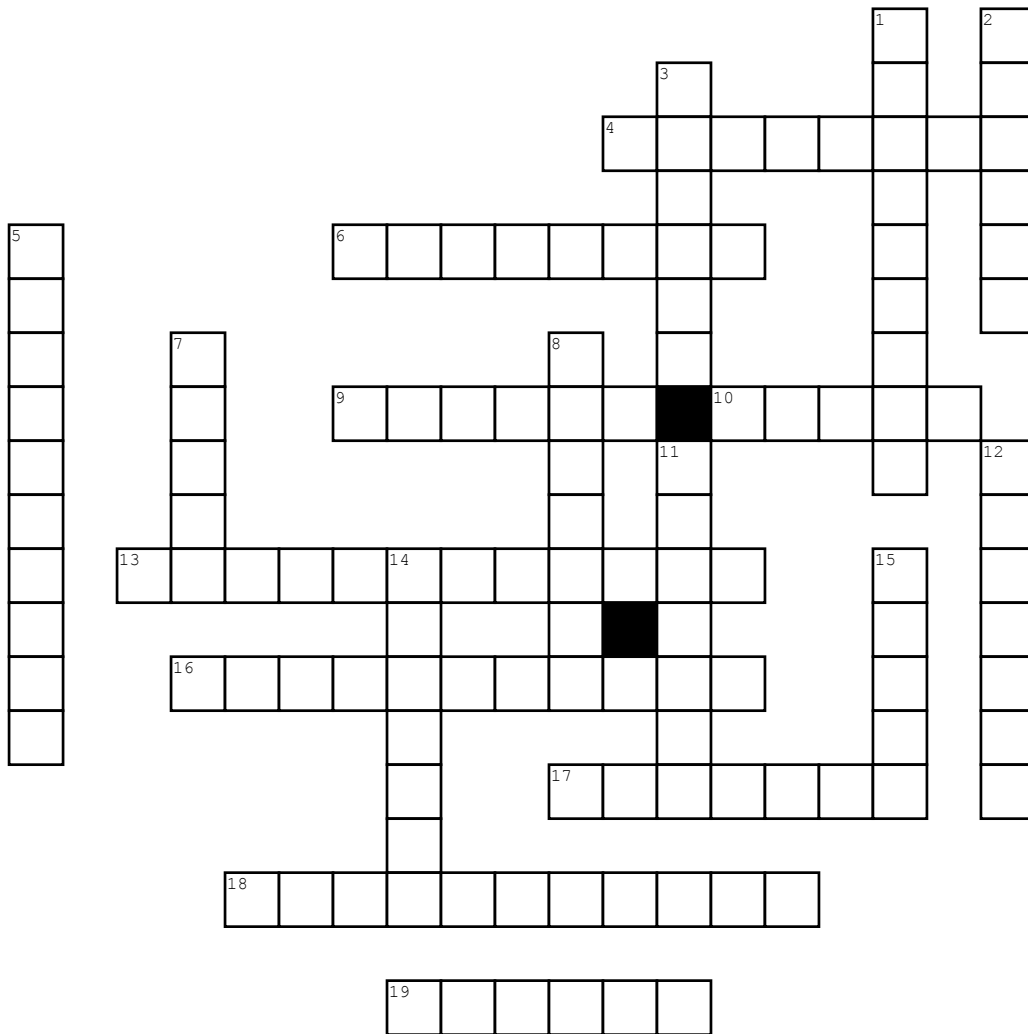

- 4. a drug that relieves pain and induces drowsiness, stupor, or insensibility.
- 6. excessive inward curvature of the spine.
- 9. a painful swelling on the first joint of the big toe.
- 10. either of a pair of bones forming the two sides of the pelvis
- 13. the surgical reconstruction or replacement of a joint.
- 16. any of the bones of the foot (metatarsus)

- 17. the skull, especially the part enclosing the brain
- 18. any of the five bones of the hand.
- 19. relating to the bones forming the human carpus (wrist)

**Down**

- 1. painful inflammation and stiffness of the joints
- 2. a small, triangular bone at the base of the spinal column in humans and some apes, formed of fused vestigial vertebrae.
- 3. the thicker and shorter of the two bones in the human forearm

- 5. two small oblong bones placed side by side at the middle and upper part of the face
- 7. the bone of the thigh or upper hind limb, articulating at the hip and the knee
- 8. relating to the ribs
- 11. the kneecap
- 12. the bone of the upper arm or forelimb, forming joints at the shoulder and the elbow.
- 14. a new piece of bone usually growing on another piece of bone, typically the skull.
- 15. the large broad bone forming the upper part of each half of the pelvis.
