


## Terms Relating to Tissues, Organs, and Systems part 2



### Across

4. pertaining to the large or small intestine  
 7. pertaining to the skin of the body  
 9. cover or surround a part of the body  
 12. the mass of tissue and organs separating the two lungs  
 14. pertaining to lymph or lymphatic vessels  
 19. upper part of the trachea (windpipe)  
 20. internal organ(s), particularly of the abdominal cavity  
 21. tissue that carries nerve impulses  
 23. tissue with the power to contract and thus produce movement; can be skeletal muscle; smooth muscle, or cardiac muscle

24. space between lungs and pleura  
 25. slippery secretion of mucous membrane: acts like a lubrication (n)  
 26. pertaining to the muscle  
 27. pertaining to organs of excretion and reproduction  
 28. space between the neck and diaphragm; houses the lungs

### Down

1. pertaining to the system of urine excretion  
 2. pertaining to the bones of the body  
 3. striped, as in the appearance of voluntary (skeletal) muscles  
 5. muscle tissue controlled by conscious effort; also called skeletal muscle

6. muscle tissue that are automatically controlled by the nervous system tissue  
 8. space within the vertebra; houses the spinal cord  
 10. relating to metabolism  
 11. relating to vessels for passage of bloody fluids  
 13. concerning the production of offspring  
 15. membrane investing the abdominal cavity and viscera  
 16. secreting mucus or covered by mucus (adj.)  
 17. pertaining to the nerves  
 18. pertaining to the lower back  
 22. pertaining to the exchange of oxygen and carbon dioxide between the atmosphere and body cells
