## Across

2. assessment during instruction-time for teachers to monitor, guide, and reteach as needed
3. extent to which a test produces a consistent, reproducible score
4. average of scores
5. most frequently occuring score
6. extent to which a test measures what it is intended to measure
7. a type of test, assessment, or evaluation which yields an estimate of the position of the tested individual in a predefined population, with respect to the trait being measured (example: ACT, PAWS)

## Down

1. May be used to determine how much students know before instruction begins and after it has finished (pre and post tests)
2. time to judge the success at the end-more formal
3. example of this assessment could be a discussion, journal, blog, or portfolio
4. middle score of a group of numbers
