

- **2.** assessment during instruction-time for teachers to monitor, guide, and reteach as needed
- **6.** extent to which a test produces a consistent, reproducible score
- 7. average of scores
- 8. most frequently occurring score
- **9.** extent to which a test measures what it is intended to measure

**10.** a type of test, assessment, or evaluation which yields an estimate of the position of the tested individual in a predefined population, with respect to the trait being measured (example: ACT, PAWS)
