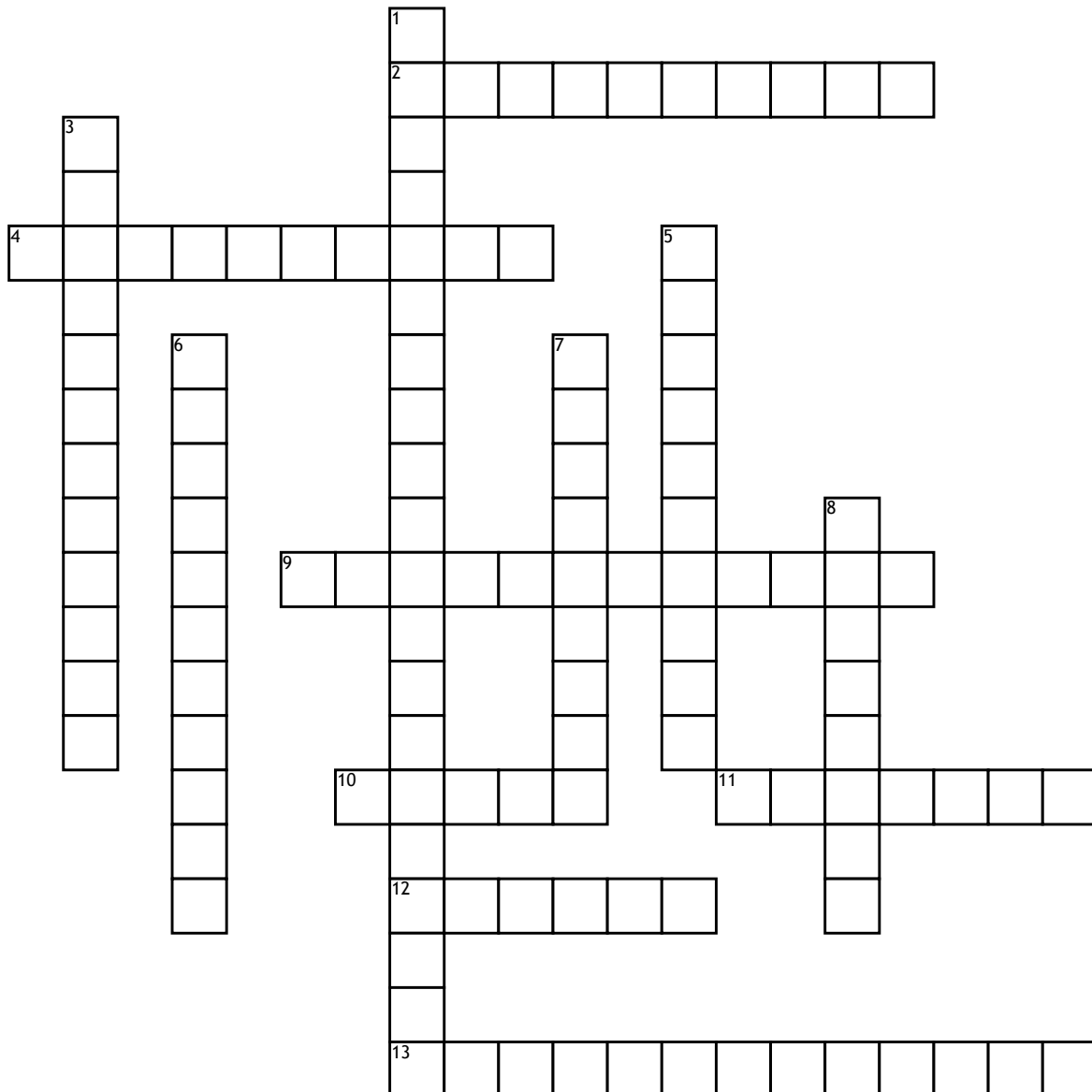


# Texas's Place on the Earth
