
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## The Bill of Rights

- **4.** Courts cannot assign excessive money for bail. No cruel or unusual punishment.
- 5. Right to bear arms/own a weapon.
- **9.** Can't be put on trial unless jury decides there's enough evidence. No re-trial. No taking private property for public use without consent from owner. Right to remain silent.
- 10. Freedom of speech, religion, and press.

## Down

- 1. Protection against unreasonable searches, warrants, and seizures unless by affirmation or oath. A person's things cannot be taken.
- **2.** Any powers not given to the government is given to the states or the people.
- 3. Right to trial by jury/have a jury present.
- **6.** People have rights beyond those listed in the Constitution.
- **7.** The accused has the right to a speedy and public trial.
- **8.** No soldier can be quartered in any house without the consent of the owner.
