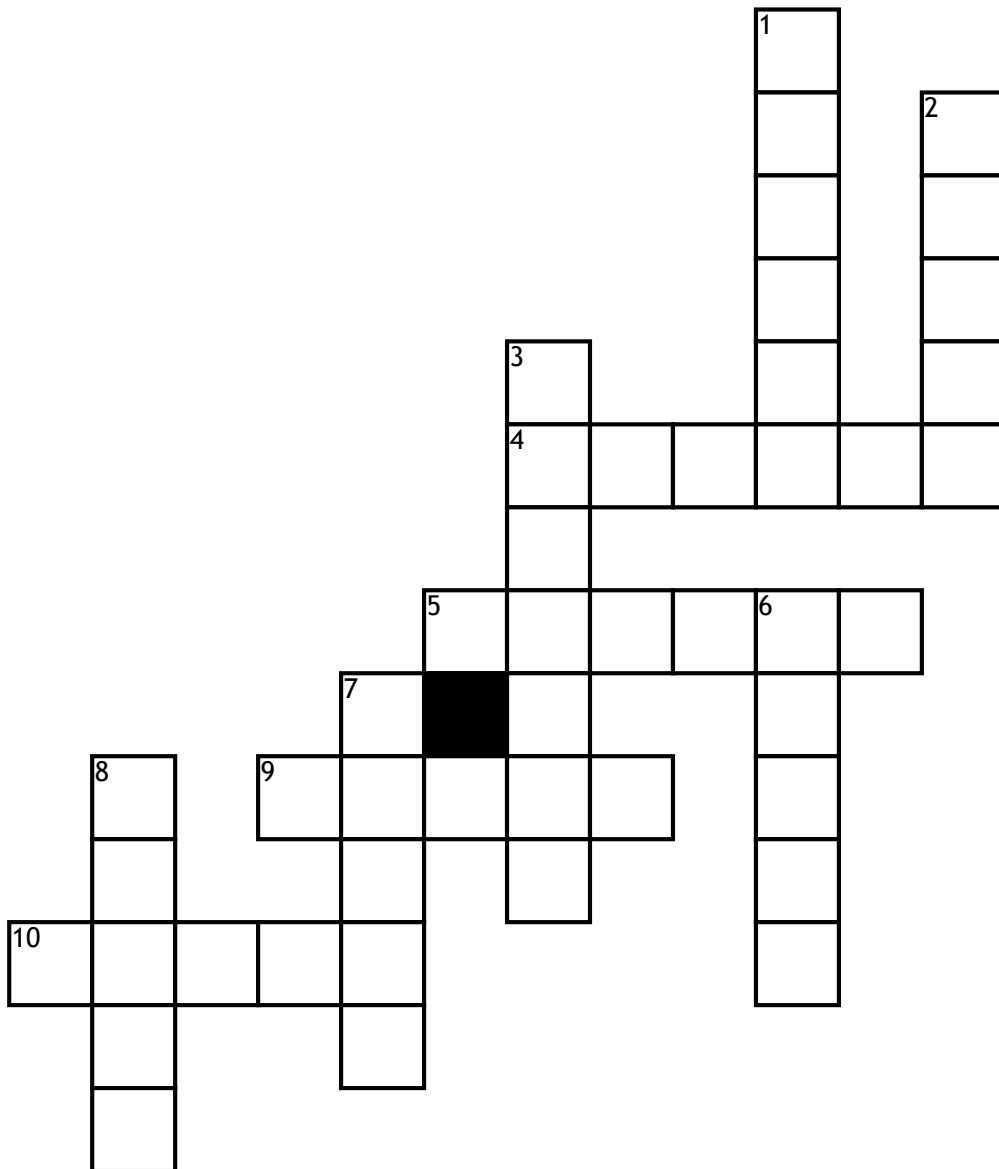

1. Protection against unreasonable searches, warrants, and seizures unless by affirmation or oath. A person's things cannot be taken.
