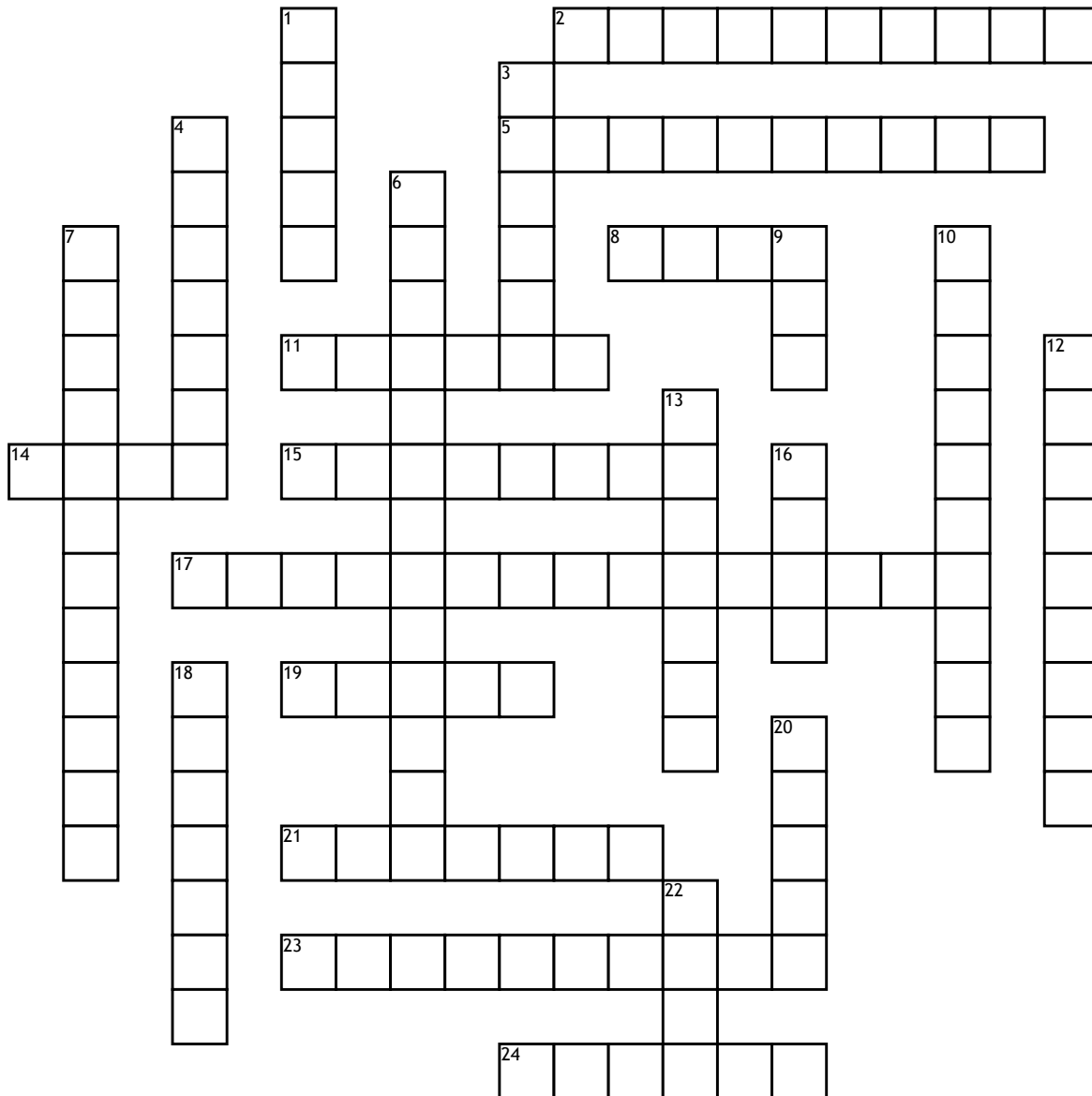


# The Blind Side By: Michael Lewis
