
The Castle

- **2.** a drawbridge that pivoted in the middle
- **5.** a secondary gate or door, often located at the rear of the castle
- **7.** protective wall at the top of a fortification, around the outer side of the wall-walk
- **8.** a deep trench, usually filled with water that surrounded a castle

 10. a round tower, built into a wall
- 11. courtyard within the walls of a castle
- **16.** vertical sliding wooden grille shod with iron, suspended in front of a gateway, designed to protect the gate
- **17.** inner stronghold of a castle
- **18.** war engine of the catapult type, employing tension

- **19.** stone throwing machine worked by torsion, used as a siege weapon against castles
- **20.** a notched battlement made up of alternate crenels and merlons
- **22.** principle living quarters of a medieval castle
- 23. engine resembling a crossbow, used in hurling large arrows
- **25.** tall, movable wooden tower on wheels, used in seiges

- 1. a small tower, rising above, and resting on one of the main towers
- **3.** an earthwork mound on which a castle was built
- **4.** a narrow, vertical slit cut into the wall through which arrows could be fired

- **6.** a wooden bridge, leading to a gateway, capable of being raised or lowered
- 9. latrine
- **12.** a jail, usually found in one of the towers
- 13. a dungeon reached by a trap door14. a small tower at the end of a
- curtain wall, or in the middle of the outside wall
- **15.** part of a battlement, the square "sawtooth" between the crenels
- 21. scaling of a castle wall
- **24.** passage between the parapet of a castle wall
