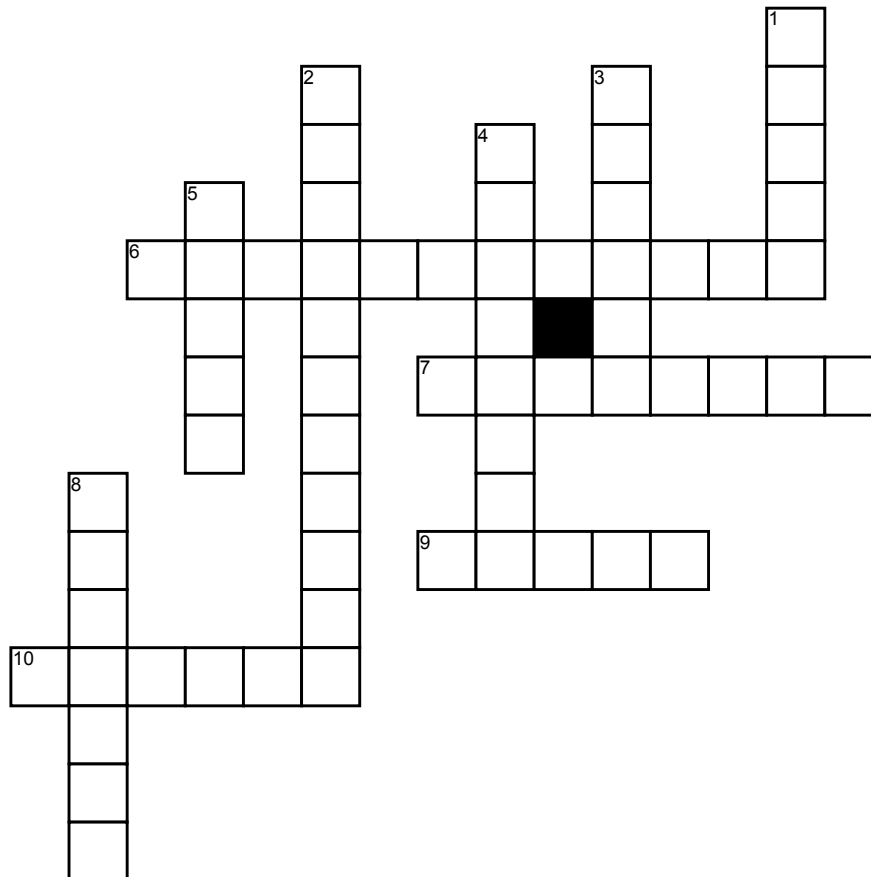


The Characters of "Romeo and Juliet"

6. Peace-loving and dislikes the violence of the feud. Like her husband, she is concerned by her son's secretive behavior.

7. Romeo's father, who is concerned by his son's melancholy behavior.

9. Montague's son; originally a comic lover, but then falls deeply in love with Juliet.

10. Capulet's daughter. Her love for Romeo gives her the strength and courage to defy her parents and face death twice.

Down

1. Juliet's nursemaid, who acts as confidante and messenger for Romeo and Juliet. Loves to talk and reminisce, and her attitude toward love is bawdy.

2. Vengeful and she demands Romeo's death for killing Tybalt. In her relationship with Juliet, she is cold and distant, expecting Juliet to obey her father and marry Paris.

3. Lady Capulet's nephew and Juliet's cousin. He is violent and hot-tempered, with a strong sense of honor. He is eventually killed by Romeo.

4. Montague's nephew and friend of Romeo and Mercutio. He is the peacemaker who attempts to keep peace between Tybalt and Mercutio.

5. A noble young kinsman to the Prince. He is well-mannered and attractive and hopes to marry Juliet.

8. Juliet's father is quick-tempered and impetuous but is initially reluctant to consent to Juliet's marriage with Paris because Juliet is so young.
