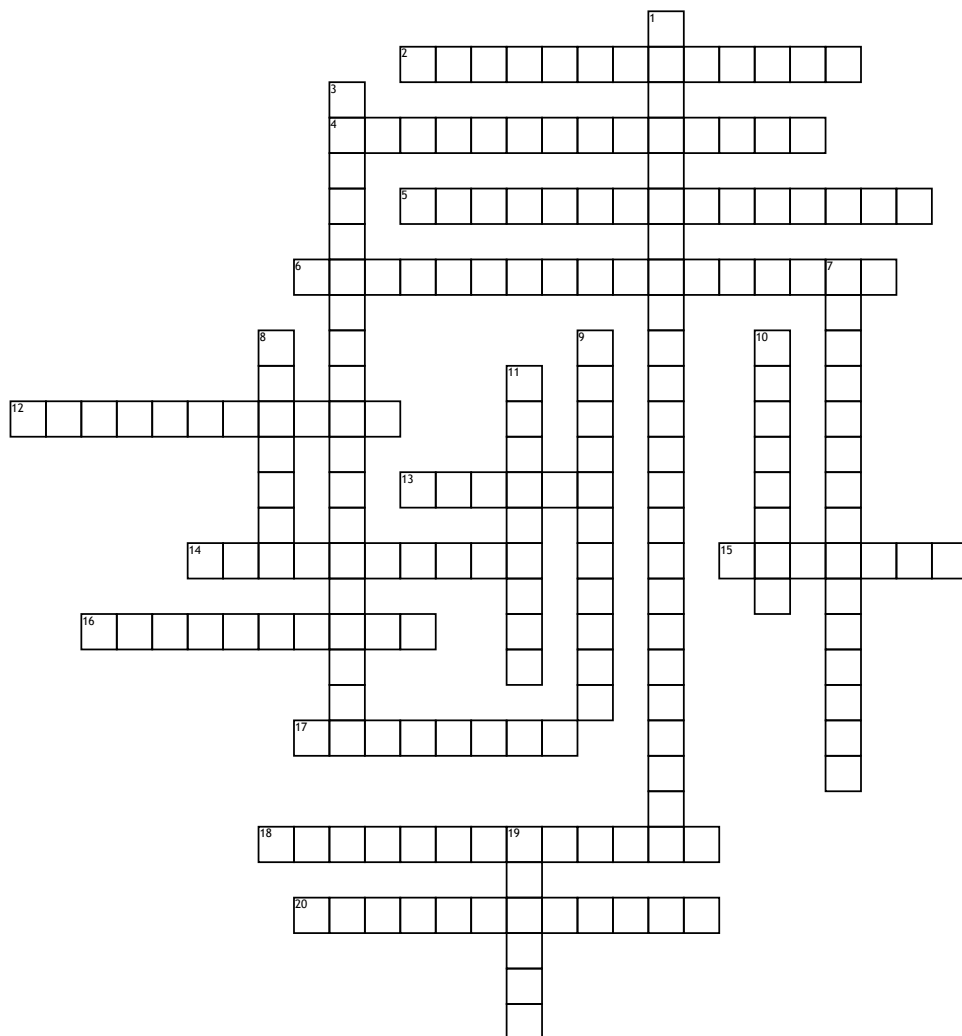


# The Civil War

17. The line drawn around a military prison outside of which prisoners were liable to be shot.

18. Eighteenth president of the United States, he received a field promotion to lieutenant general in charge of all Union forces after leading a successful battle.

3. American author and daughter of Lyman Beecher, she was an abolitionist and author of the famous anti-slavery novel, Uncle Tom's Cabin.

8. the first major battle of the Civil War; the South was victorious

9. The 11 secessionist slave-holding Southern states who attempted to leave the Union after Lincoln's election in 1860

10. Bloodiest single-day battle in American history- 23,000 casualties.

11. The withdrawal from the Union by Southern states after the 1860 election of Abraham Lincoln.
