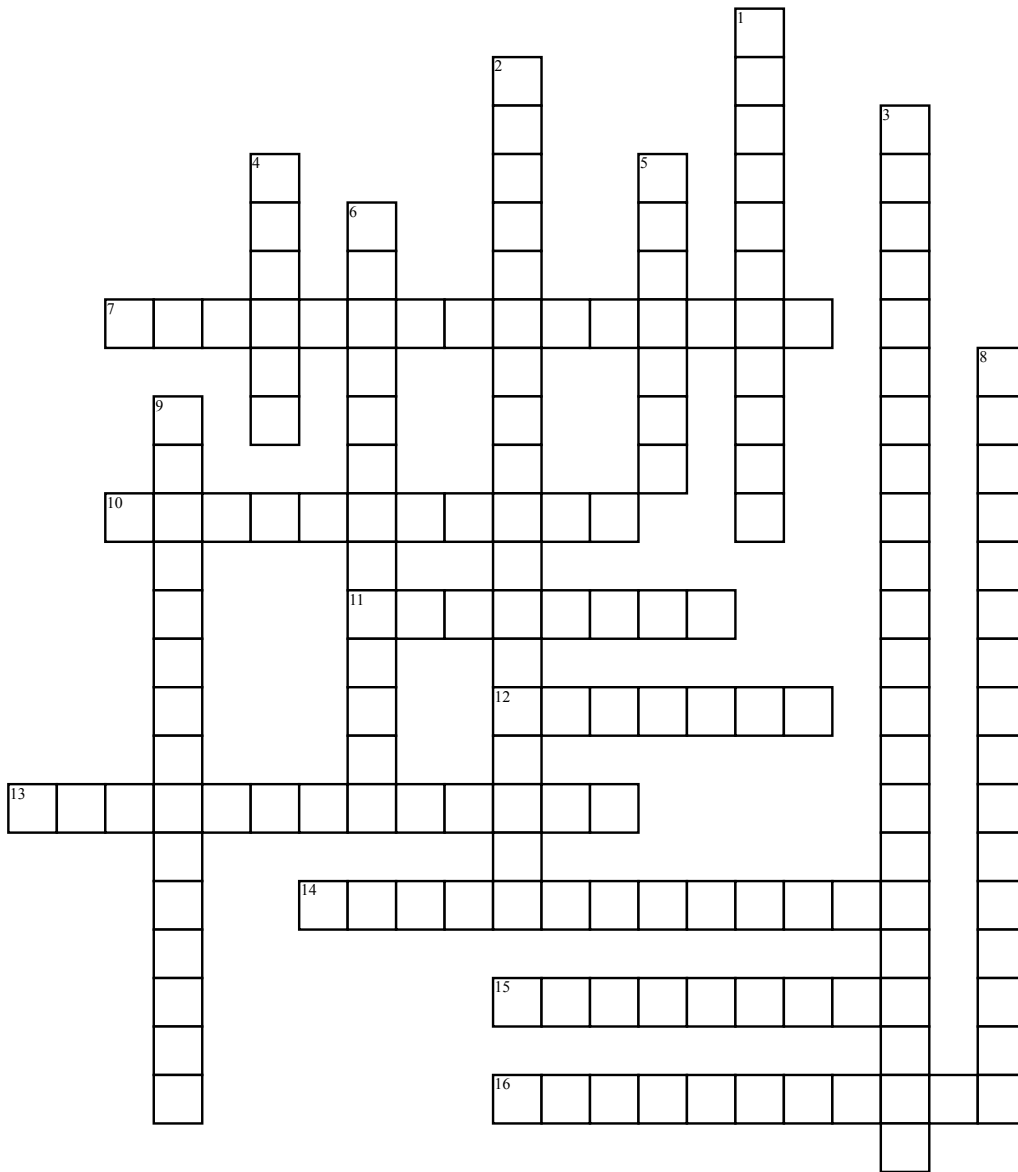


# The Executive Branch
