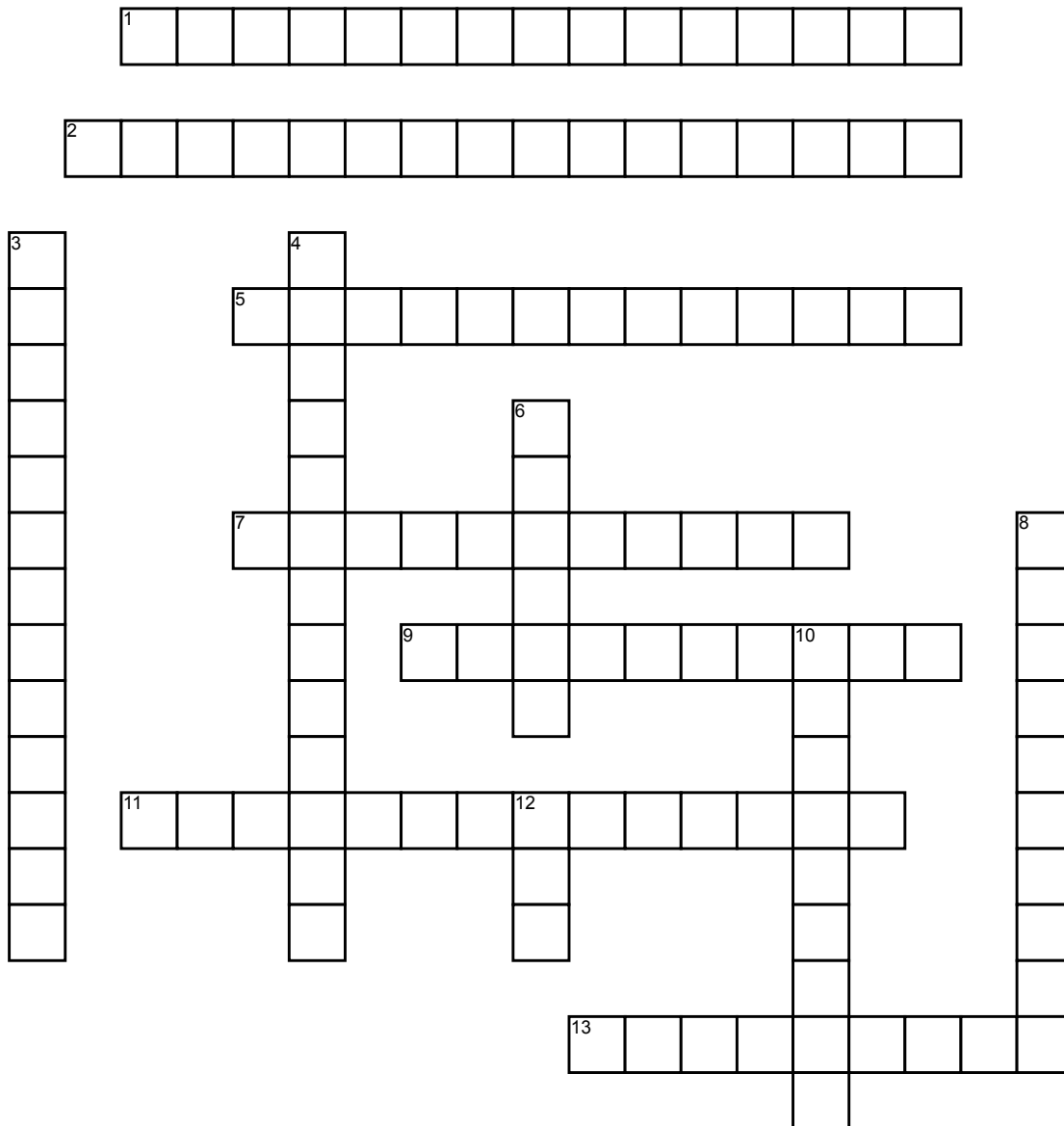

# The Expressed Powers



## **Across**

- 1. Powers that are expressly in the Constitution
- 2. Government funding of spending by borrowing
- 5. The right of the government to expropriate any private property for public uses
- 7. Banknotes or coins that must be accepted if it is offered by payment of debt
