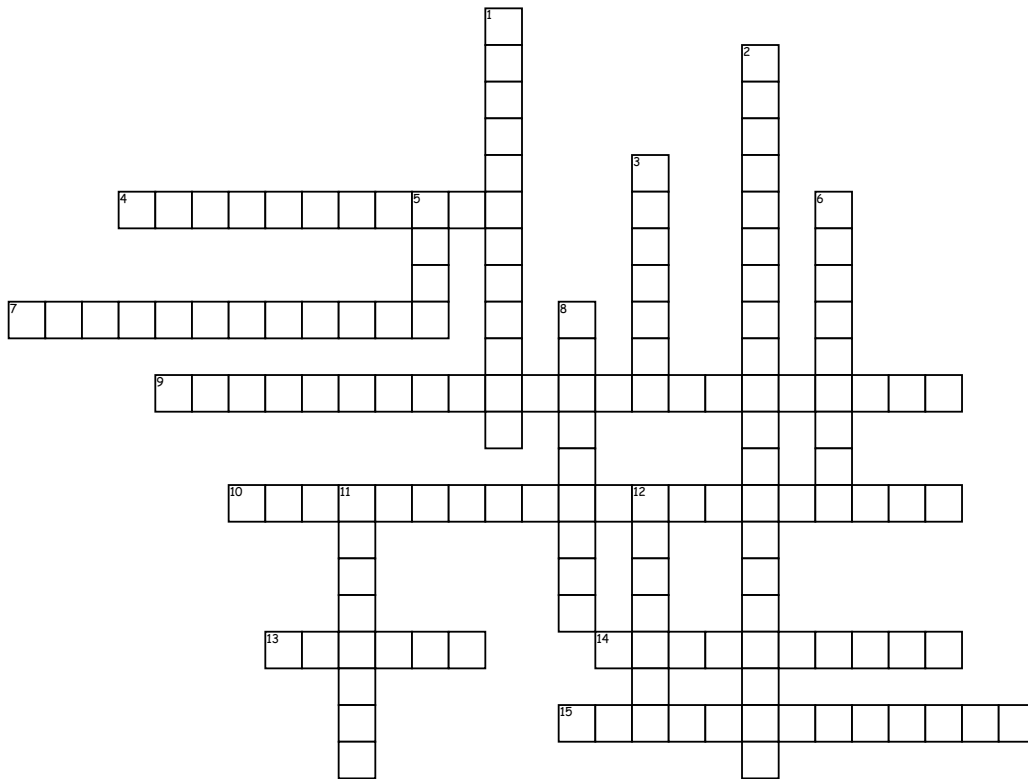


# The Industrial Revolution
