
The Mass

2. We call on the Holy Spirit to bless the gifts of bread and wine, recalling Jesus' words and actions on the last supper.

5. The deacon or priest dismisses us and processes out while we sing.

13. on some Sundays we sing this hymn
15. reading that is usually from the New Testament letters, the Acts of the Apostles

16. The priest blesses us while we make a sign of the cross.

17. This prayer expresses the the theme of the celebration and the needs and hopes of the assembly

18. we stand to sing this or other words of praise, this shows we are ready to hear the good words of Christ

19. The whole assembly prays together, stating what we believe

21. We pray that Christ's peace is with us, we offer a sign of peace.

22. We are shown the host and receive this

23. The assembly sees their sins and proclaims the mystery Gods love and asks for mercy <u>Down</u>

1. We say or sing aloud the Lamb of God asking Jesus for his mercy. The priest breaks apart the Host, inviting us to share.

3. usually the old testament, we hear of gods love and mercy before the time of Christ

4. The third part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

6. after reflecting in silence as God's Word we just heard

7. We pray for the needs of God's people.

8. The priest asks God to bless and accept our gifts.

9. The clergy process to the altar10. The Priest makes sign of the cross and reminds us we are in the presence of God

The priest offers the final prayer.
 Jesus gave us this prayer that we pray aloud or sing to our Father
 the deacon or priest proclaims a reading from the gospel of Matthew,

Mark, Luke, or John.
