
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The Middle Ear Crossword



Across

- 2. This ascends from the tympanic cavity through a small canal on the under surface of the petrous portion of the temporal bone.
- Smallest muscle in human body.
- 8. A large irregular cavity that leads backward from the epitympanic recess into the 4. The seventh cranial nerve. tympanic or mastoid antrum.
- 10. Located on the superior wall of the middle ear. Contains the head of the malleus and the body of the incus.
- 11. A small nerve originating in the tympanic plexus that carries preganglionic parasympathetic fibers to the otic ganglion.

Down

- **1.** A rounded hollow prominence, formed by the projection outward of the first turn of the cochlea.
- 3. One of three cranial nerves involved in taste that runs through the middle ear.
- 5. The pars tensa and the pars flaccida make up this.
- **6.** Activated by a puff of air to the face.
- 9. The three smallest bones in the body.
