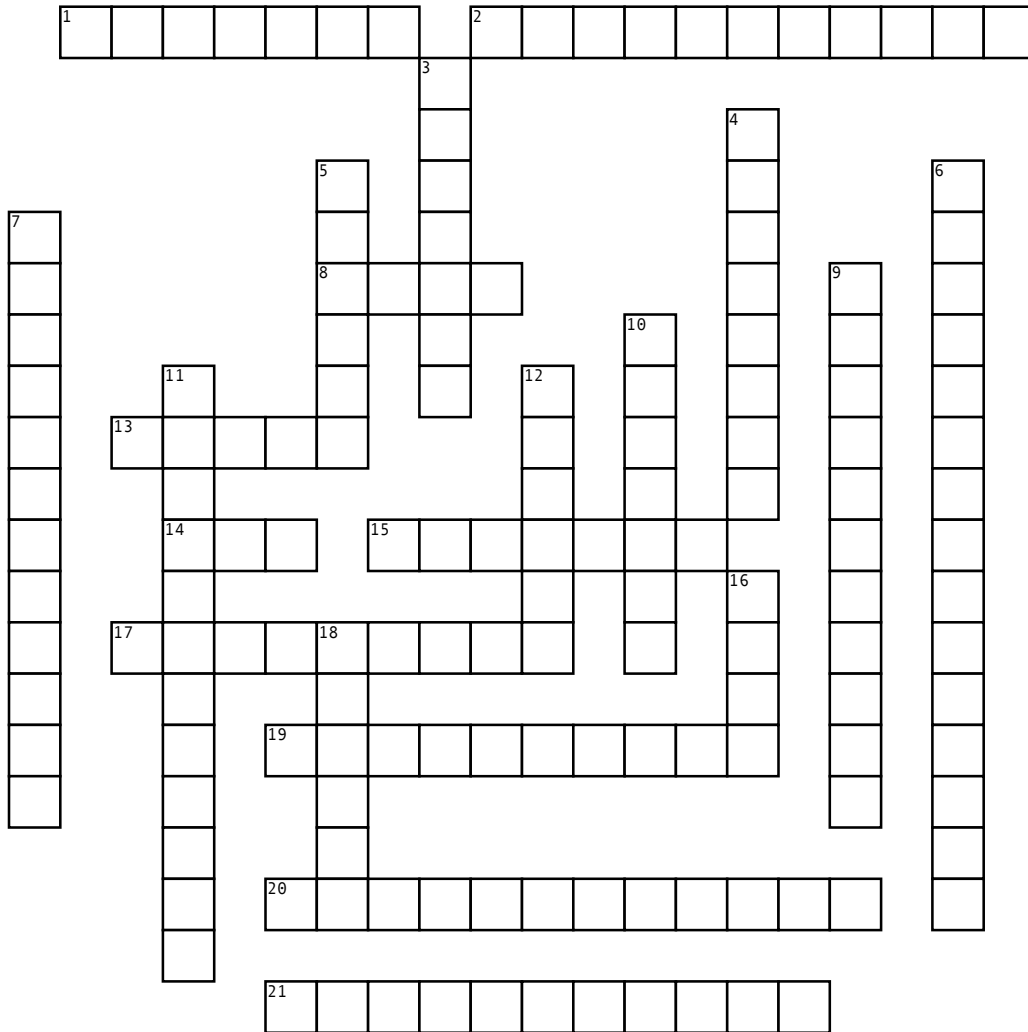


The Moon and Planets
