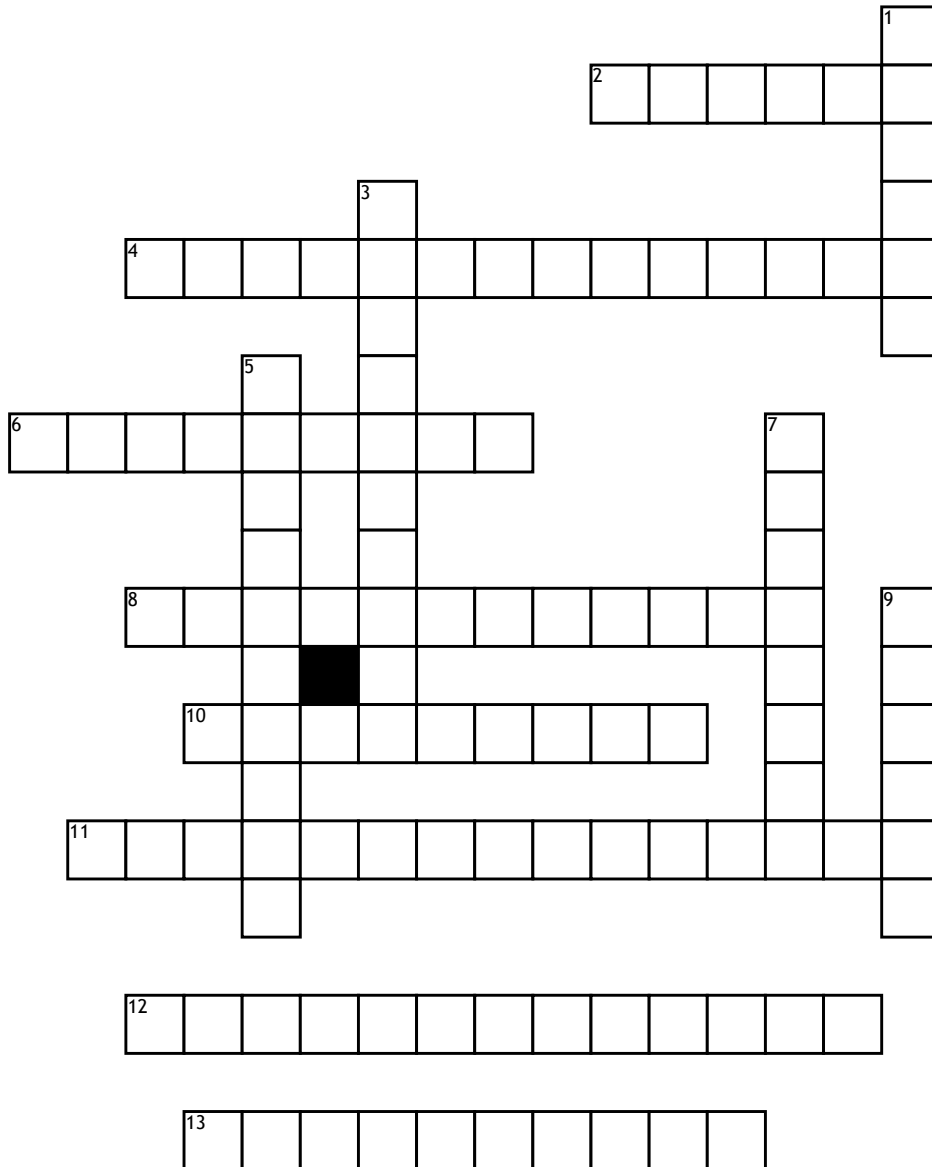


The Muscular System

2. the muscle that closes a joint
 4. the muscles attached to bone that cause body movements
 6. a pair of large triangular muscles extending over the back of the neck and shoulders and moving the head and shoulder blade.
 8. the muscles that act on the lining of the body's passageways and hollow internal organs
 10. one of the three posterior thigh muscles. the single largest tendon found behind the knee

11. a triangular muscle that covers the lower part of the back to the arm pits
 12. a type of striated muscle that forms the wall of the heart
 13. large fleshy muscle group covering the front and sides of the thigh

1. a large muscle on the back of the upper limb of many vertebrates. It is the muscle principally responsible for extension of the elbow joint
 3. the inflammation of a tendon

5. a large muscle in the upper chest, fanning across the chest from the shoulder to the breastbone.
 7. the muscle that opens a joint
 9. this occurs when an organ or tissue protrudes through an area on weak muscle
