
The President, VP, Cabinet and Independent Agencies

6. term for the President as the vested with the executive power of the United States

7. term for the President as commander of the nation's armed forces

8. the practice of giving job to supporters and friends

9. type of veto a chief executive may use after a legislature is adjourned

10. often called the cabin departments, they are traditional units of federal administration

<u>Down</u>

1. term for the President as the representative of the people, working for the public interest

2. the power to issue orders, directives, rules or regulations that have the effect of law

3. additional agencies created by Congress located outside of the cabinet departments
4. term for the president as the ceremonial head of the United States, the symbol of all the people of the nation

5. deals with succession to the Presidency and establishes procedures both for filling a vacancy in the office of the Vice President as well as responding to Presidential disabilities.
