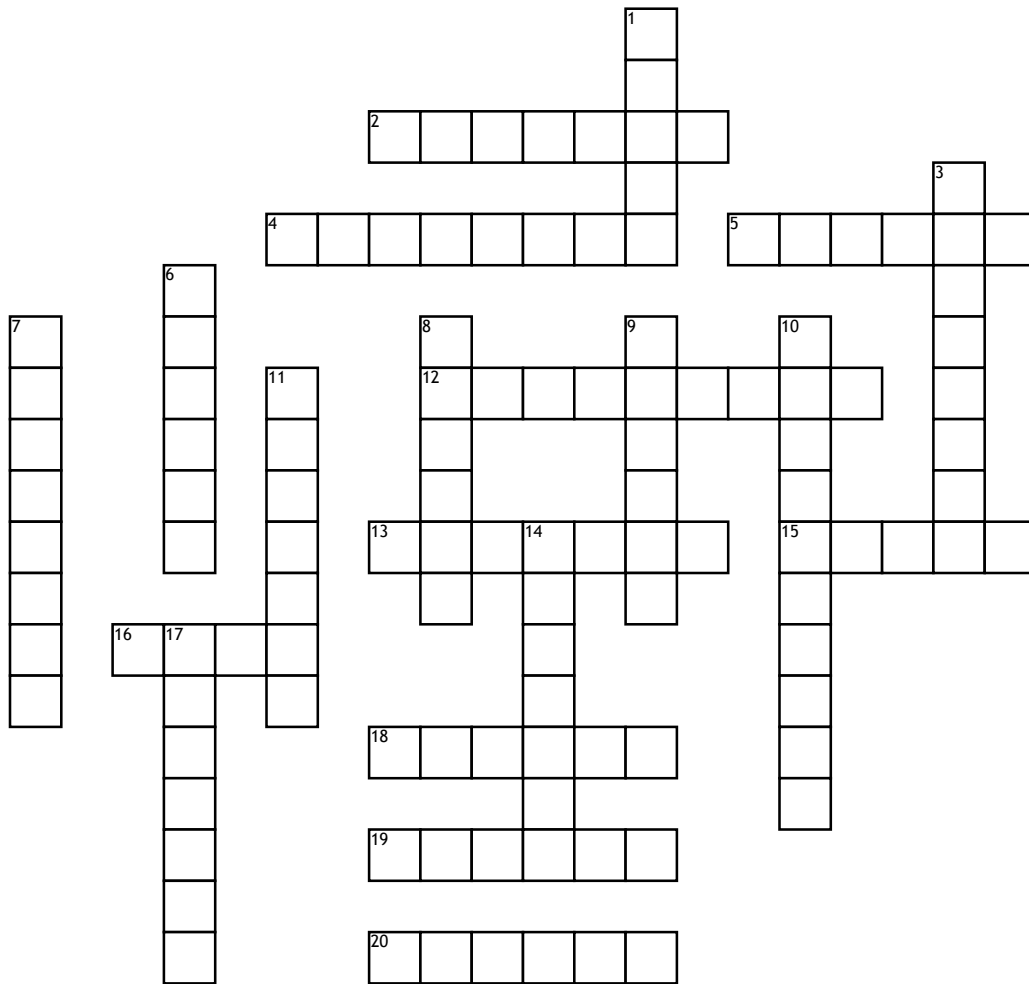


The Raven Crossword
