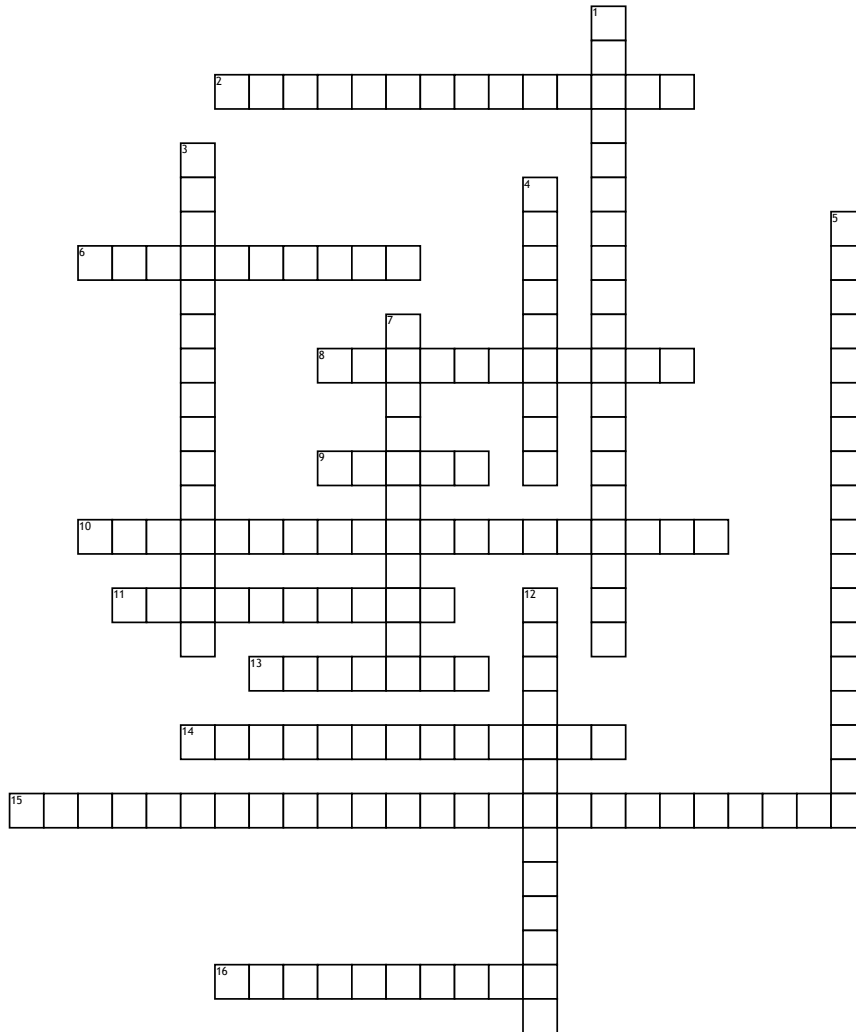


The Reconstruction Era

- 2. A period after the Civil War when the southern states were reorganized
- 6. removed restrictions on Confederates
- 8. limited rights of blacks
- 9. the man who won the election of 1868 by electoral votes
- 10. a constitutional amendment giving full rights of citizenship to all people born or naturalized in the USA except Native Americans
- 11. laws denying most legal rights to newly freed slaves

- 13. a tax required to register to vote
- 14. a derogatory term applied to Northerners who migrated south during Reconstruction
- 15. divided the South into five districts under military rule
- 16. A secret terrorist society created by white southerners after the Civil War

- 1. amendment that outlawed slavery and had to be ratified in each state

- 3. an organization run by the army to protect southern blacks after the Civil War
- 4. a derogatory term for Southerners working with the North to buy land from desperate Southerners
- 5. prohibited any state from denying citizens the right to vote on grounds of race, color, or previous condition of servitude
- 7. a formal document charging a public official with misconduct in office
- 12. a system in which farmers worked land owned by someone else
