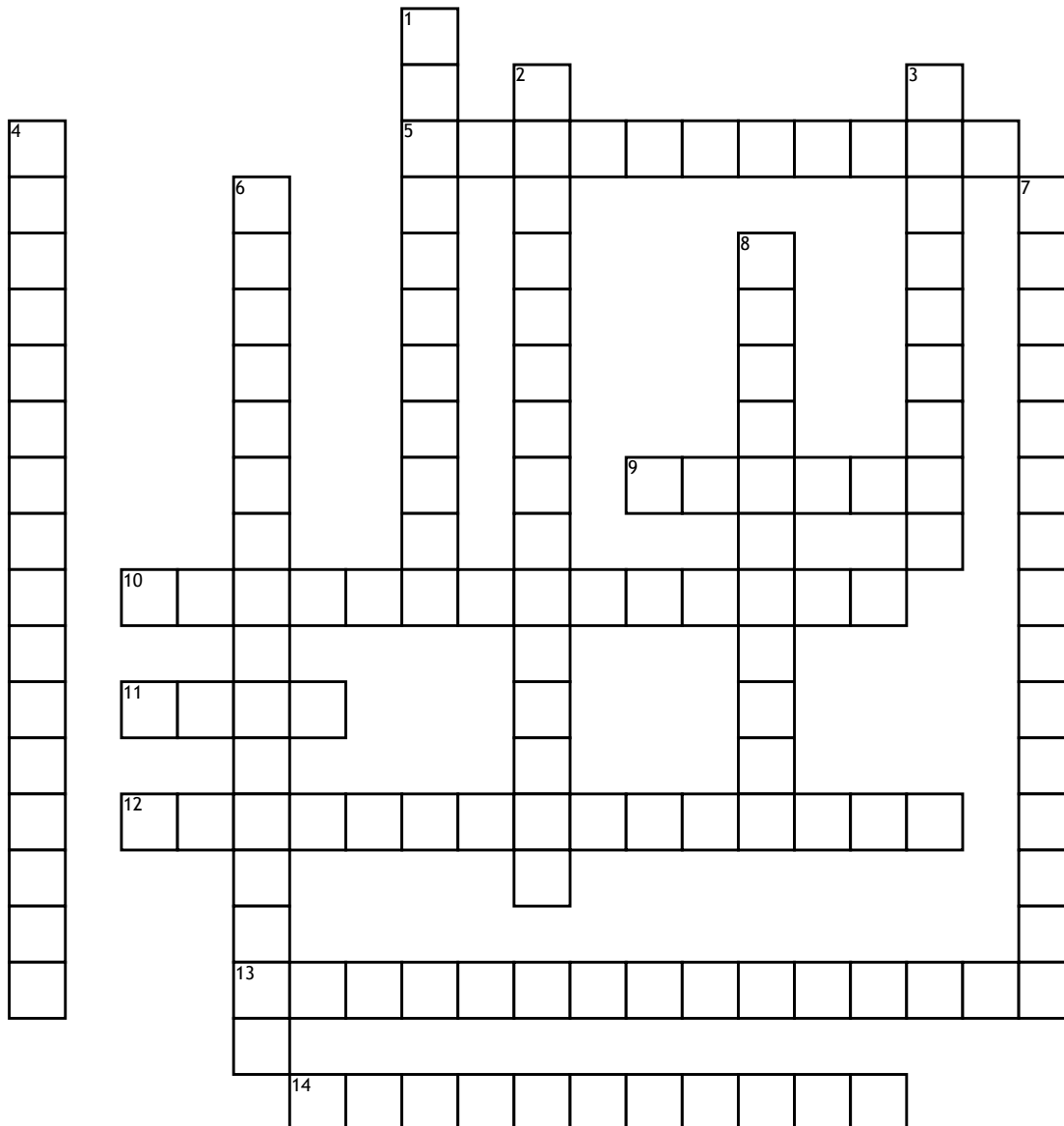


# The Scalp



## Across

5. Deepest layer of the scalp

9. Lattice like tissue that lies between inner and outer layer of skull.

10. Thin layer of meninges between dura mater and pia mater.

11. Outer layer of scalp.

12. Covers the forehead and dome of the skull.

13. Tissue that enables upper layer of scalp to move over lowest layer.

14. Connects the occipitalis muscle at the rear of head to frontalis muscle.

## Down

1. Located inside of spongy bone of skull.

2. The sphincter muscle surrounding the mouth.

3. Tough fibrous membrane that lines inside of skull.

4. Muscle at side of head, felt when clenching teeth

6. Flat muscle surrounding the eye.

7. Tissue that contains blood vessels, second layer.

8. Begins in the occipital bone, joins aponeurosis, pulls back scalp
