# The Skull

1. between the frontal and parietal bone
  2. dividing both the parietal bones
  3. running horizontally between the occipital bone and both parietal bones
  4. the caudal boundary of the cerebral cranium
  5. bones forming large parts of the top and the side of the head
  6. Bone that consists of three parts: the squamous part the orbital part the nasal part
  7. an unpaired skull bone which covers the back of the head
  8. a large, bilaterally symmetrical bone which forms the base of the cranial vault
  9. most complex bone of the human body. Shaped like a bat
  10. suture, separates frontal bone from parietal bones
  11. suture, separates the two parietal bones
  12. sinuses, both superior medial to the orbits, anterior to the anterior cranial fossa, abscess could present a serious problem
  13. sinuses, below the orbit, on either lateral side of the nasal passage
  14. sinuses, behind the nasal passage, level with the orbits, allows surgical access to the sella turcica for pituitary tumor removal
