
The Urinary System

- **4.** also known as the urinary system; function is to filter and remove waste products from the body
- $\boldsymbol{8.}$ this instrument is used to measure specific gravity of urine
- 9. this organ filters blood and produces urine
- 11. the first stage of urine production; filtering of particles
- **14.** the last stage of urine production; when ammonia uric acid and other waste are secreted into the renal tubule
- 15. this organ filters waste from the blood
- 18. combining form that means bladder or pouch
- 22. this organ transports urine to the bladder
- **25.** also known as Bowman's Capsule; a ball that holds capillaries
- 26. pertaining to the renal pelvis
- 29. the external opening that allows waste to exit the hody
- 31. inflammation of the urinary bladder
- ${\bf 33.}$ branch of medicine that involves the treatment and diagnosis of disease in the urinary system

- 34. inflammation of the renal pelvis
- **35.** this drug is used to prevent or reduce muscle spasms of the bladder
- 36. small biologically important molecules
- **37.** an example of substances sometimes found in urine that should not be there; a protein that should stay in the blood
- 38. the outer portion of the kidney, acts as a shell
- 39. stone in the ureter

- 1. the ball of capillaries inside the Bowman's Capsule

- **12.** branch of medicine involves the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the kidney
- **13.** the second stage of urine production; when most of the water electrolytes and nutrients are reabsorbed into capillaries
- 16. pain the the bladder
- 17. this organ acts as a tube to remove waste from the body
- 19. to surgically repair the renal pelvis
- 20. the inner portion of the kidney
- **21.** also known as the Loop of Henle; connects the proximal convoluted tubule to the distal convoluted tubule
- 23. this organ stores urine
- 24. X-ray of the kidney
- 27. suffix that means condition of stones
- 28. to cut into an organ to remove a stone
- 30. folds that allow the bladder to expand
- 32. prefix that means difficult or painful
