

- 4. Islam canonical law based on the teaching of the Quran and the traditions of the prophet.
- 6. a tax levied on non-Muslims as they were not entitled to defending the Arabian empire, as Muslims were entitled to drafting
- 8. Persian physician and philosopher whose medical textbook, The Canon of Medicine, is a comprehensive medical encyclopedia that remained a standard work in European medical studies until the 17th century; also called Avicenna
